However, the **English Premier** League is one of the best in the world and has some world-famous clubs like Arsenal, Liverpool and Manchester United.



There is a museum which has the championship trophies on display and there are guided tours of the famous 'centre court'.

















Game in cricket has arisen in the Middle Ages in England. The oldest competitions on cricket — The Ashes traditional meetings between England and Australia.

Back in Scotland, Murrayfield stadium holds record rugby crowd of 104000 and the stadium now has its own tour.












The history of horse races in **England has** begun in a XVII-th century when members of royal family had special breeds of horses for races.
