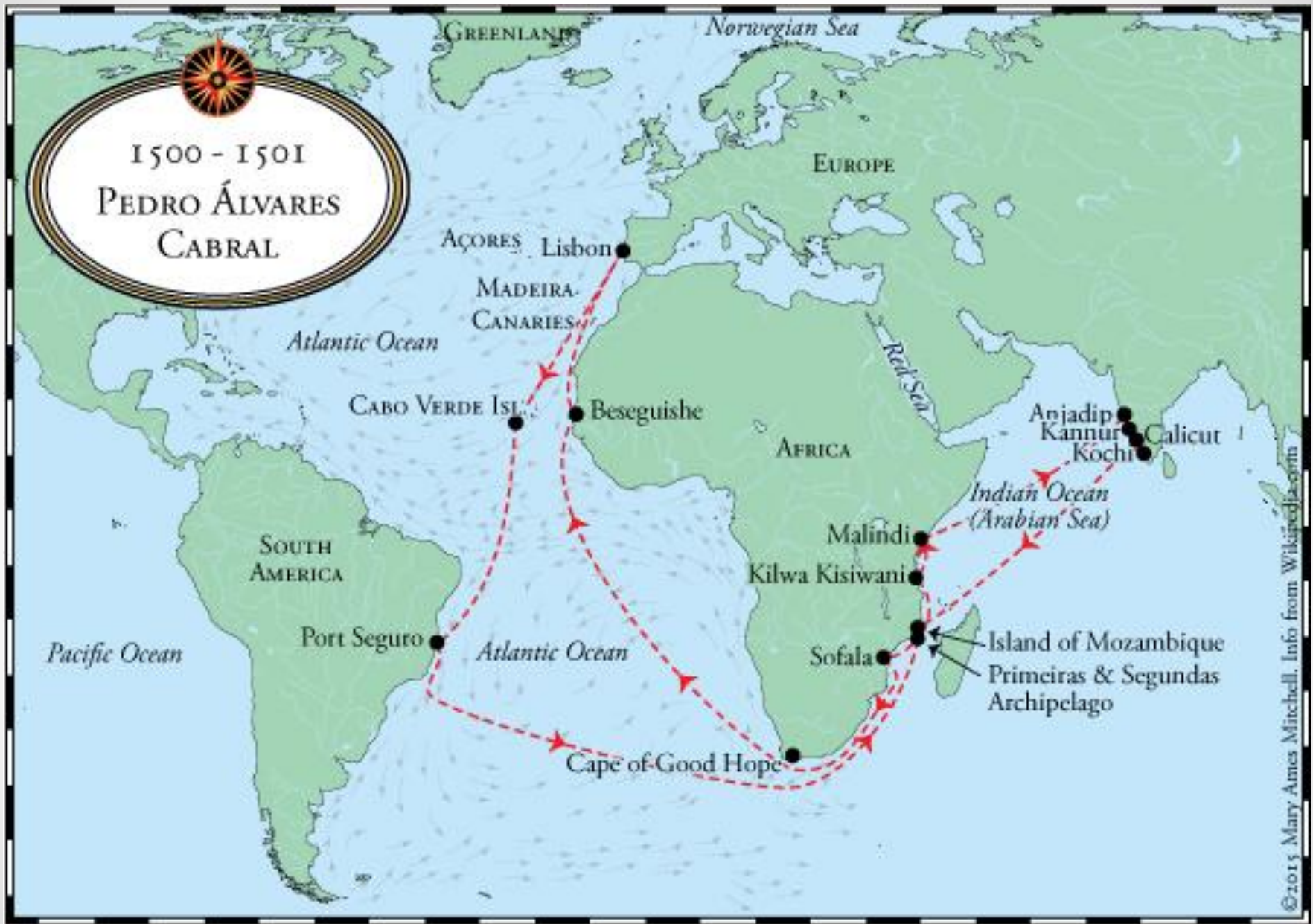

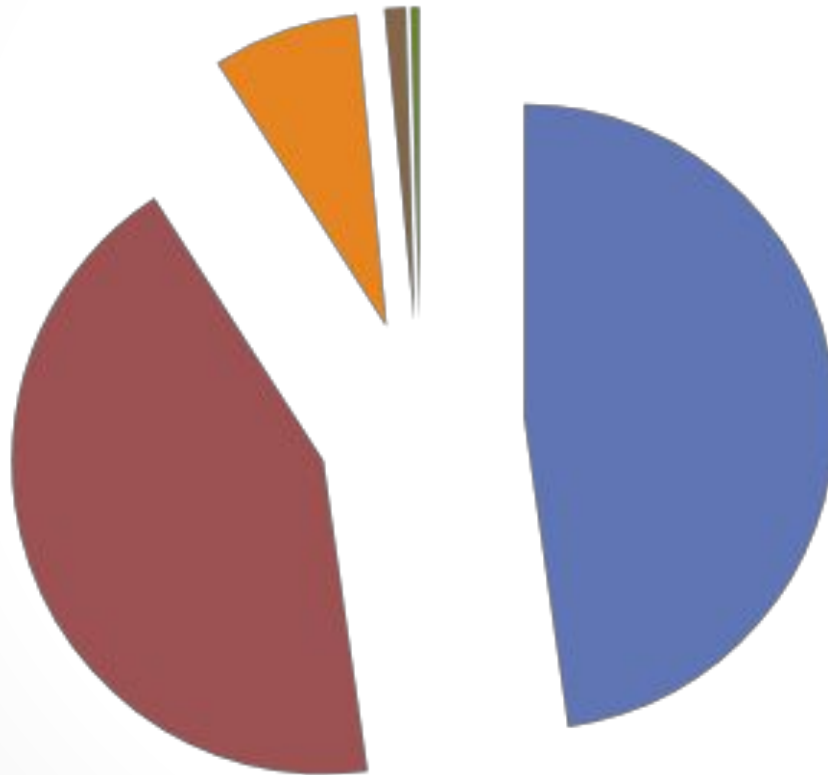

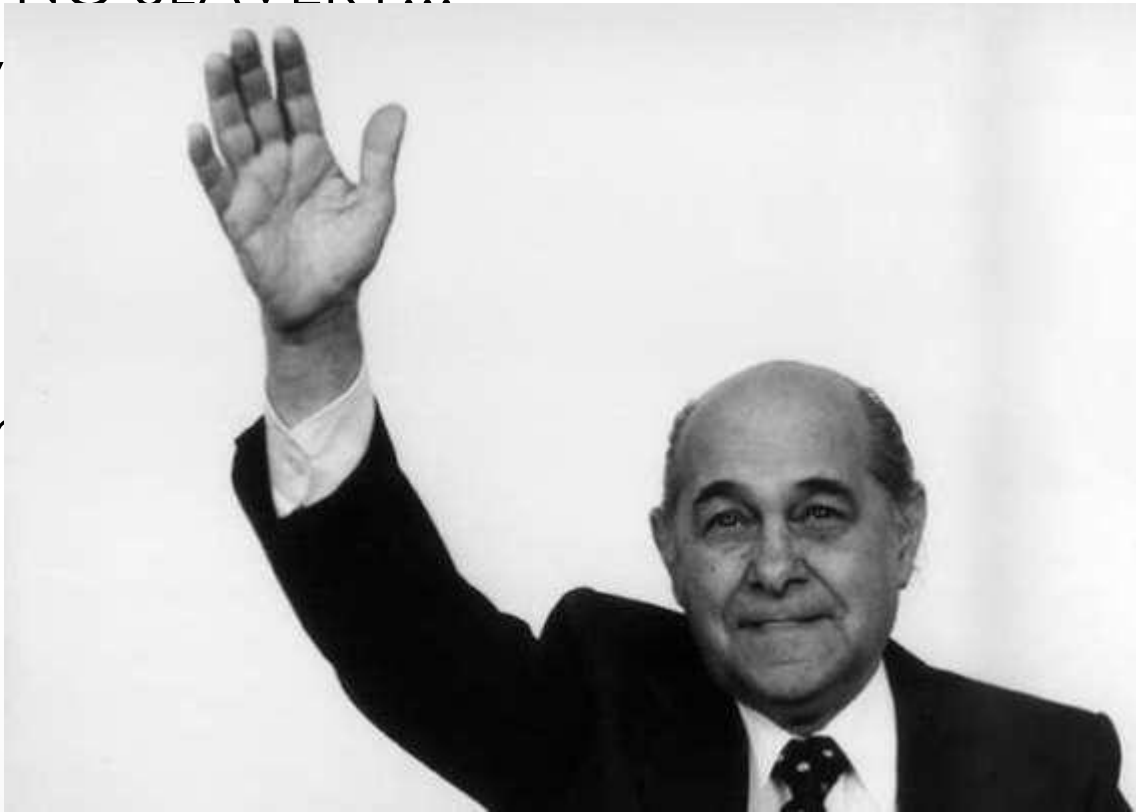

Political Regime

- 1988 Democratic constitution: presidential or parliament?
- President is a head of the state and the government. President and Vice president are elected for a four-year term.
- Legislature: National Congress (Chamber of Deputies and Federal Senate)
- The highest judicial level is Federal Supreme Court.
- Lower levels are corrupted.

Political regime

- President, state governors and mayors of cities are elected in a 2 round election.
- 26 states (+1 federal district), governors are elected, have unicameral legislature
- Brazil's military plays enormous role in domestic politics.

Political Conflict and Competition

- Multiparty system with weak parties.
- 21 parties hold seats
- The weakness: no ideoloji, only charismatic leaders
