

How to Make the Perfect Cup of British Tea



English custom of drinking tea

☐ If drinkers sit round the table, they leave tea saucer on the table;

☐ If guests go around the room or stand the must have tea saucer in the left hand and the cup in the right hand;

☐ The cup is taken only with two fingers.



Tea recipes

1. "Gun-fire" Английский огонь чай.

You need: 1 packet (50 grams) of tea, 1 liter of water, 1 liter of alcohol, 200-250 grams of sugar

2. Custard Английский "Яичный чай" (кастерд)

You need: 5-6 spoons of black tea, 100 ml boiled water, 500 ml boiled cream., 2-3 yolks, sugar

3. English tea with spices "Чай по-английски с приправами"

You need:1 glass of made tea, some cinnamon, 1 teaspoon of cloves, 3 teaspoons of lemon peel.
