- **Mikhail Vasilyevich Lomonosov**
(08.11.1711-04.04.1765) is the first Russian natural scientist of world importance, man of encyclopedic knowledge, varied interests and abilities, founder of Moscow State University, one of the founders of physical chemistry, artist, historian, poet, who laid the foundations of the modern Russian literary language, advocate of national education and development of independent Russian science.

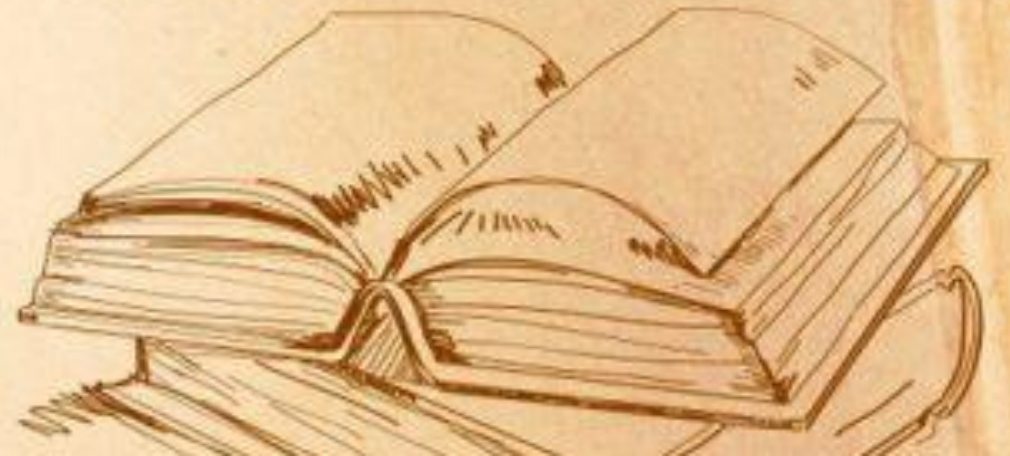

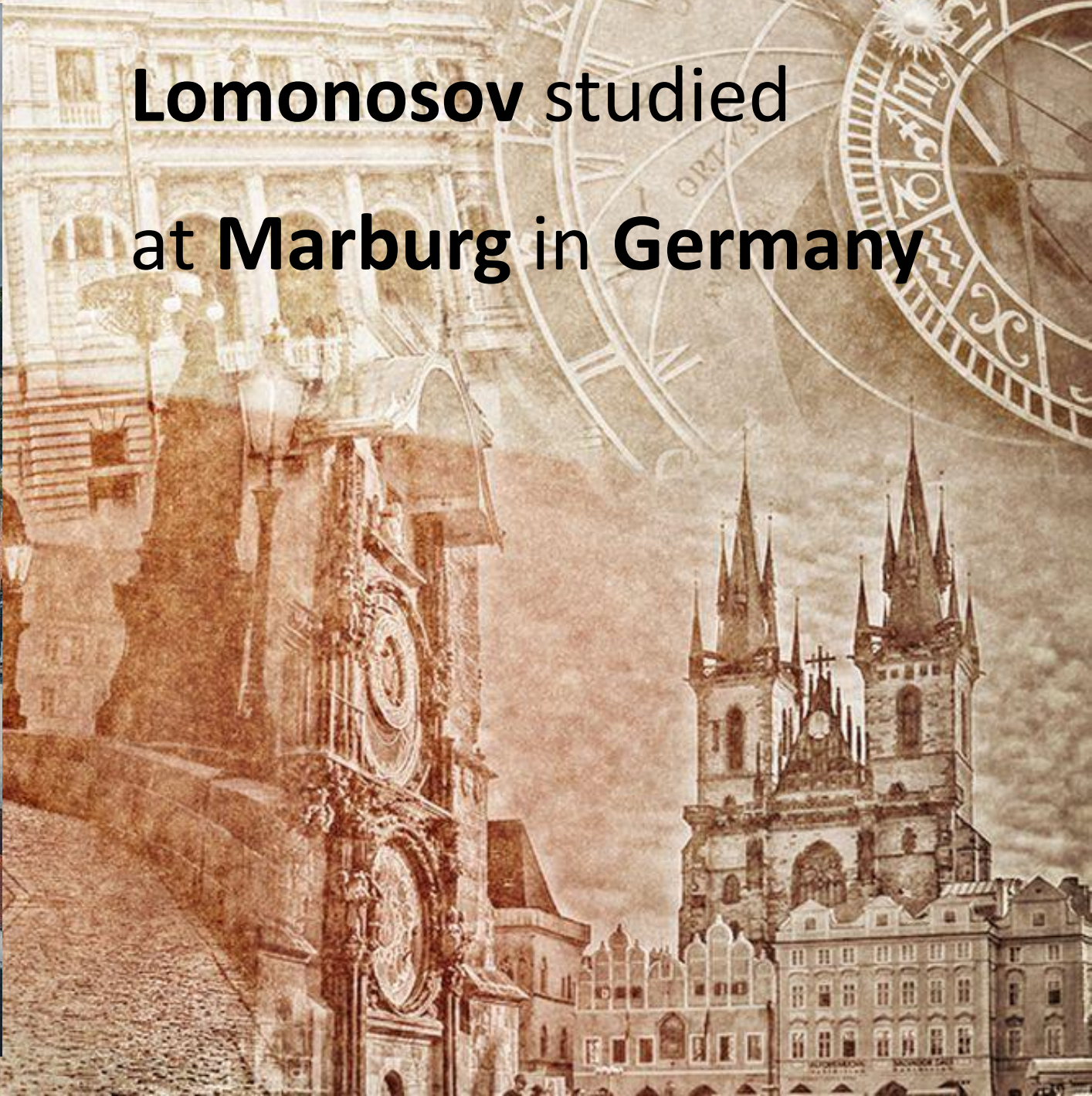

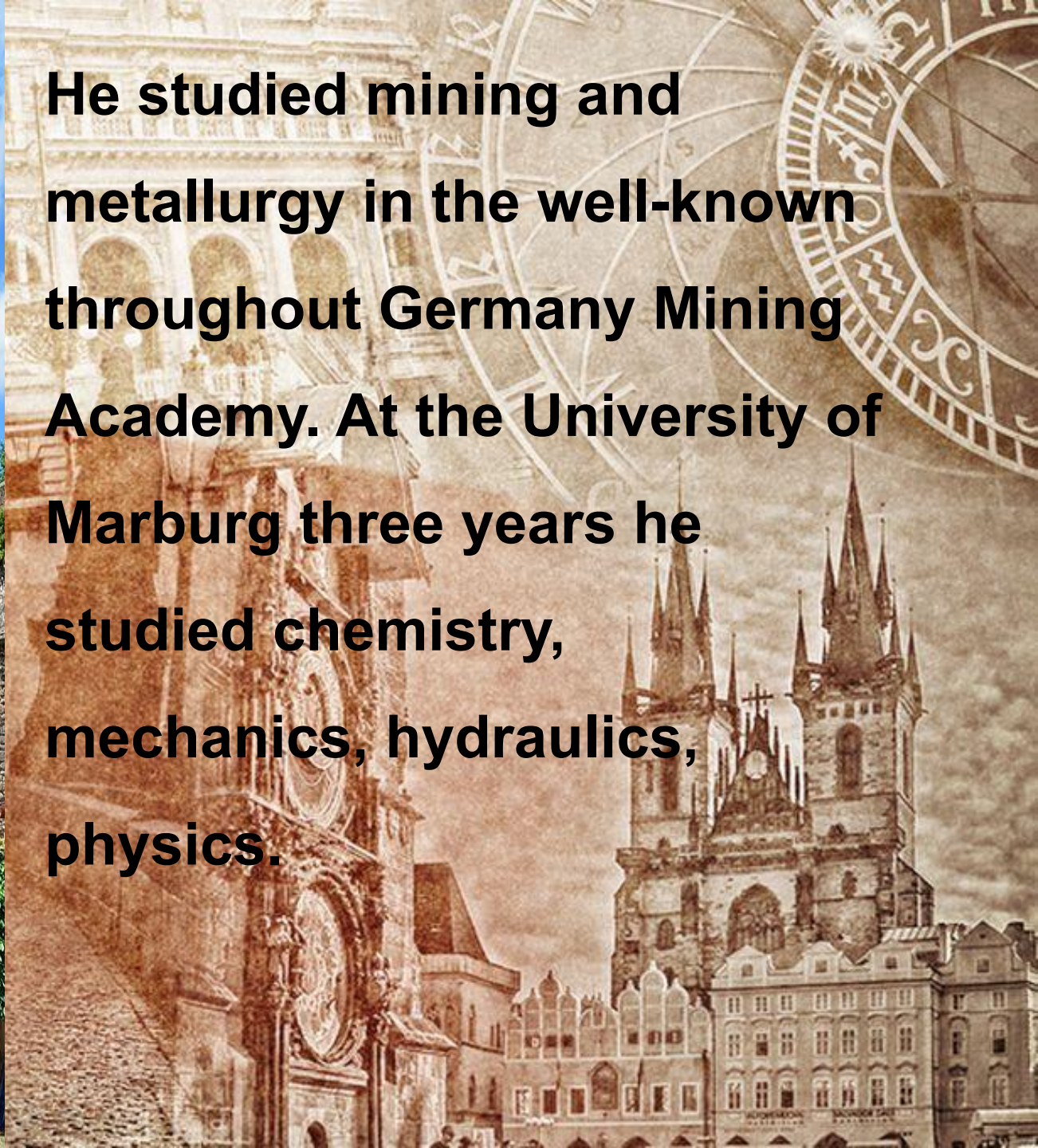


**Lomonosov studied
