• The Romanov Dynasty was the 2nd imperial dynasty to rule Russia.

• The Romanov family reigned from 1613 until the abdication of Tsar Nicholas II on March 15, 1917.

• Father - Patriarch Filaret, cousin of Fyodor Ioannovich, the last Tsar from Rurik family.

Mother - Ksenia Shestova (nun Marpha)

ZEMSKY ASSEMBLY


- The candidacy of Mikhail Romanov turned out to be a compromise in many aspects
- Boyars could make a pressure on the Tsar when solving key issues due to his age
- Patriarch Filaret (his father) was an authority in the ranks of the clergy
- The Romanov dynasty cooperated less with the "unpatriotic" Polish government in 1610-1612



Tsar Mikhail Fedorovich was young and inexperienced, and until 1619 the country was ruled by his mother and her relatives.

After liberation in 1619 from the Polish captivity of the patriarch Filaret, the actual power passed into the hands of the latter.
