Good job!

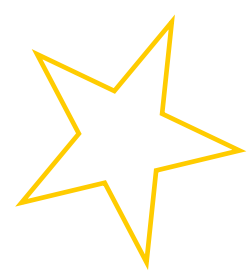
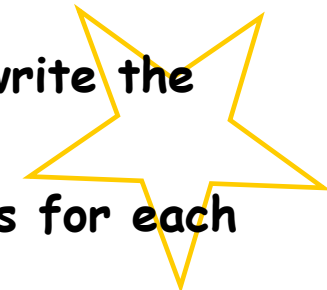
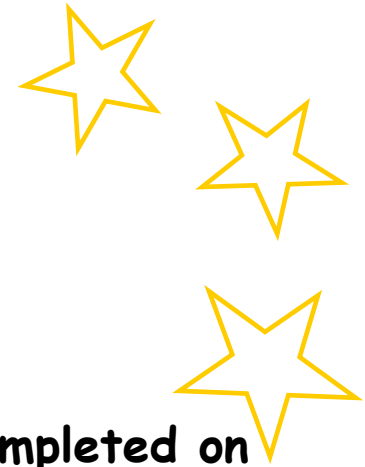

Goofy is such a bad skier.



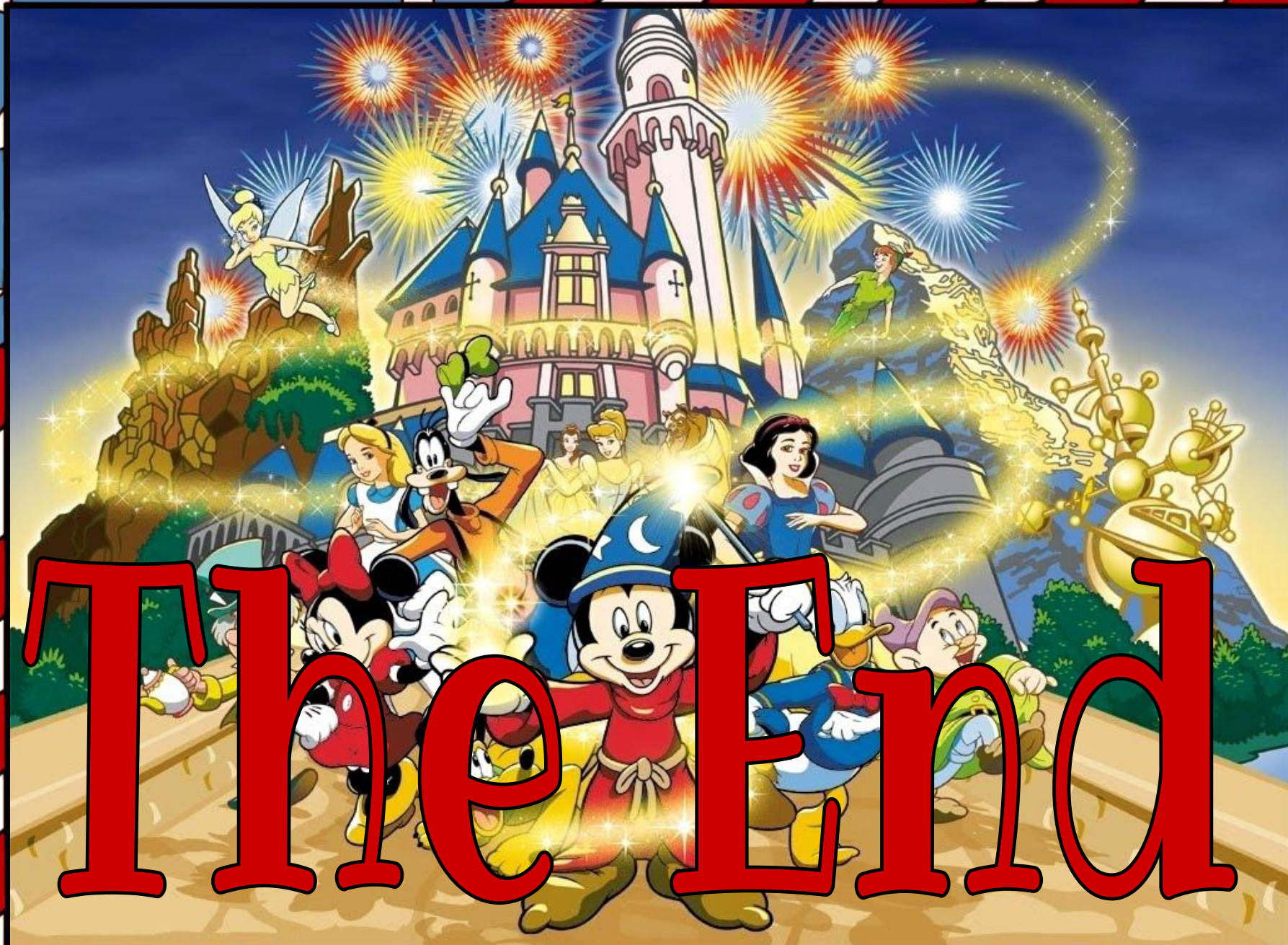
