



Search app database for community made module/topic sticky notes


Accessed throughout app with this button




Users can add the entire module straight to their Flashcards



Users can delete Flashcard topics that they no longer need


Flashcards divided into modules or topics. Modules added from the community or created by users are displayed here



> Users can add as many Flashcards as they want




