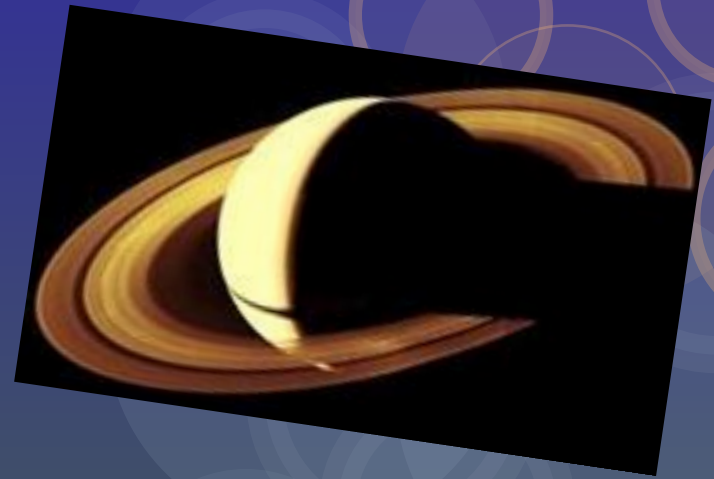

CHIP



- ❑ POT – flower pot, kitchen pot, teapot, marijuana
- ❑ ELEMENTS – water, wind, fire, earth
- ❑ POP – I only drink pops (lemonades), music genre, pop a balloon, pop something open
- ❑ RING – a piece of jewellery, boxing ring, to call somebody, planetary ring
- ❑ KEY – music key (bass), device to lock/open the door, key on a keyboard/piano
- ❑ DRAW – without a winner, use a pencil or crayons to make a picture, draw a gun
- ❑ LINK – web link, link of a chain, relationship, cufflinks
- ❑ DEGREES – of Celsius/ Fahrenheit, academy degree, angle

- ❑ CROWN – a ruler, a jewel, currency (Czech crown on the picture), tree crown
- ❑ TEAR – a drop of salty water from eyes, to tear a piece of paper, tear in a wall, tear a rope (make sure the pronunciation is correct in all cases as it differs)
- ❑ CHANGE – railway change, after and before change, coins (usually cash back)
- ❑ DUCK – to dodge/to cover your head, to duck dive, rubber duck, animal
- ❑ ROLL – toilet roll, roll the dice, Swiss roll, spring vietnamese rolls
- ❑ JACK – heaver, a card, jack o'lantern, connector
- ❑ CHIP – chocolate chip, fish and chips, crisps, electronic chip. (explain the difference for chips in Britain and America)
