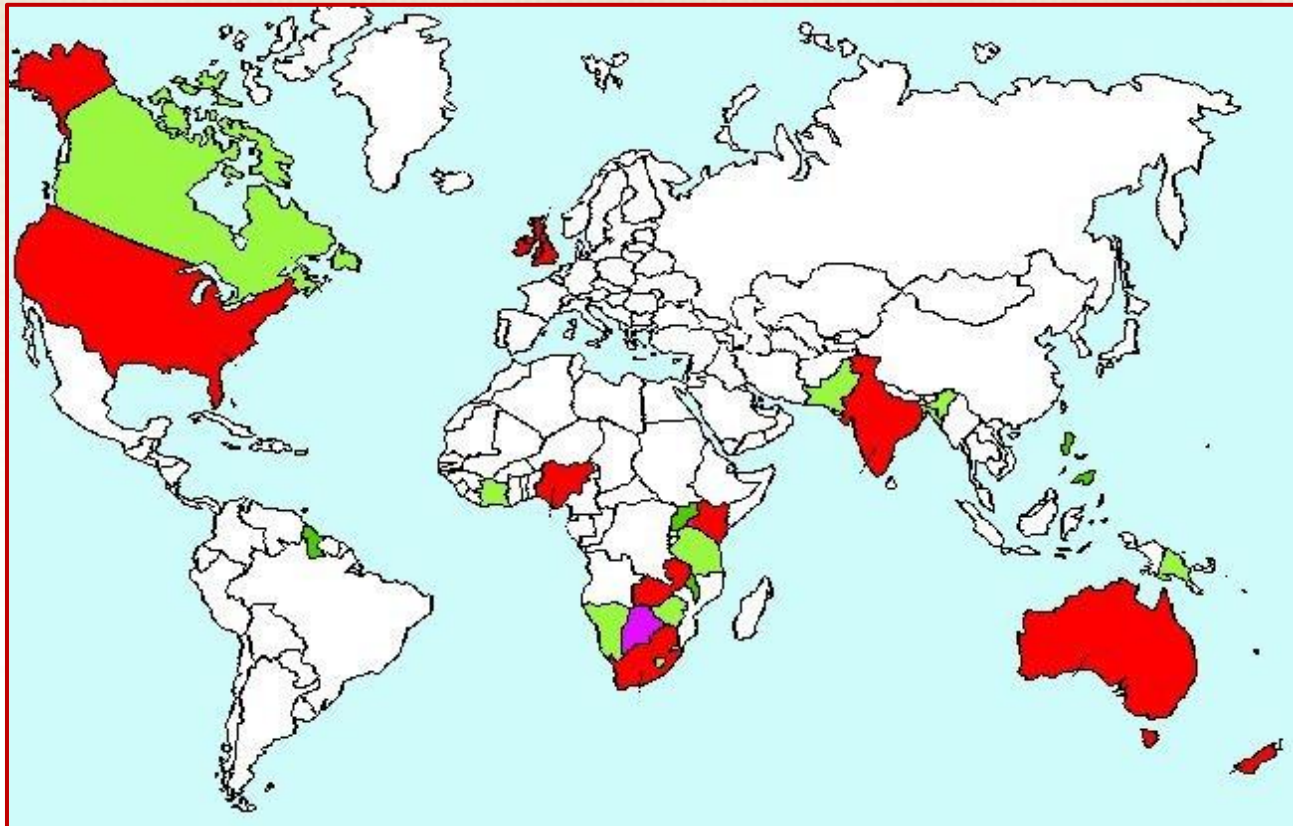
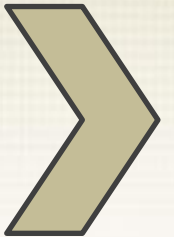

- Choose the difficulty every time you answer



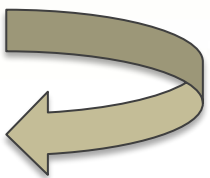
