- Affirmative sentences
- Countable nouns
- Ex.: There are lots of trees in the park. There are a lot of apples. uncountable nouns
- Ex.: There is a lot of sugar in the jar.

*A lot of/ lots of can be used in questions and negative sentences but they are not commonly used.

Affirmative sentences

Plural countable nouns – used in formal language

EX.: <u>Many</u> books are in the library. <u>Many</u> flowers are on the table. <u>Many</u> children are playing in the park.

NEGATIVE SENTENCES

Ex.: There aren't many books in this bookstore. I don't have many cds.

QUESTIONS

Ex. : How many apples would you like? Are there many employees in your company?



MEGATIVE SENTENCESQUESTIONS

Singular Uncountable nouns

Ex. : There isn't much sugar left. I don't have much money. How much is this? How much water do you drink a day?

Affirmative sentence -used in formal language

Much has done to improve the quality of this picture.

NegativeQuestions

countable nouns

We haven't got <u>any</u> grapes in the fridge.

Is there a restroom around here?

Uncountable nouns

There isn't <u>any</u> water. Do we need <u>any</u> furniture?



Affirmative

Countable nouns

Ex.: There are some chairs here. I have some managers in the company. Uncountable nouns

There is some water in the bottle.

I have some information about the sales.



To offer and ask for things, use SOME.

Ex.:

Offer Would you like some coffee?

Ask

Can I have some bread, please?

Could you lend me **some** books?
