hadn't left

would leave

didn't leave



ok

If you hadn't left so late, you would have caught the last bus.

Conditional Clauses

wouldn't leave

wouldn't have left

didn't leave

OK



I ...wouldn't have left... , if they hadn't asked me to.

Conditional Clauses

hadn't gone

didn't go

wouldn't go



ok

If I hadn't gone to the cinema last night,
I'd have seen the accident.

Conditional Clauses

studied

ok

'd have studied

had studied



He would have become an English teacher if he had studied languages.

Conditional Clauses

would be

hadn't been

weren't



ok



He wouldn't have been killed if he
.....hadn't..... a police-officer.
been

Conditional Clauses

hadn't married

OK

wouldn't have married

wouldn't marry



I ..wouldn't..have..married.. you if I hadn't
fallen in love with you!

Conditional Clauses

wouldn't come

didn't come

hadn't come



ok

I would have had a great time if he
...hadn't come at all!

Conditional Clauses

had

had had

'd have had

OK



They would have bought the car if they
..... **had had** enough money.

Conditional Clauses

would have been

would be

had been



ok

She very happy, if she had seen them there.

Conditional Clauses

would know

had known

knew

OK



I'm sure they'd have told us at once if they **had known** anything.

Conditional Clauses

weren't

wouldn't be

hadn't been



ok



I would have been on holiday with you if I ...hadn't..... sick.

Conditional Clauses

had been

OK

'd have been

would be



If they had robbed the bank, they
'd have been... arrested by now.
