start\leave

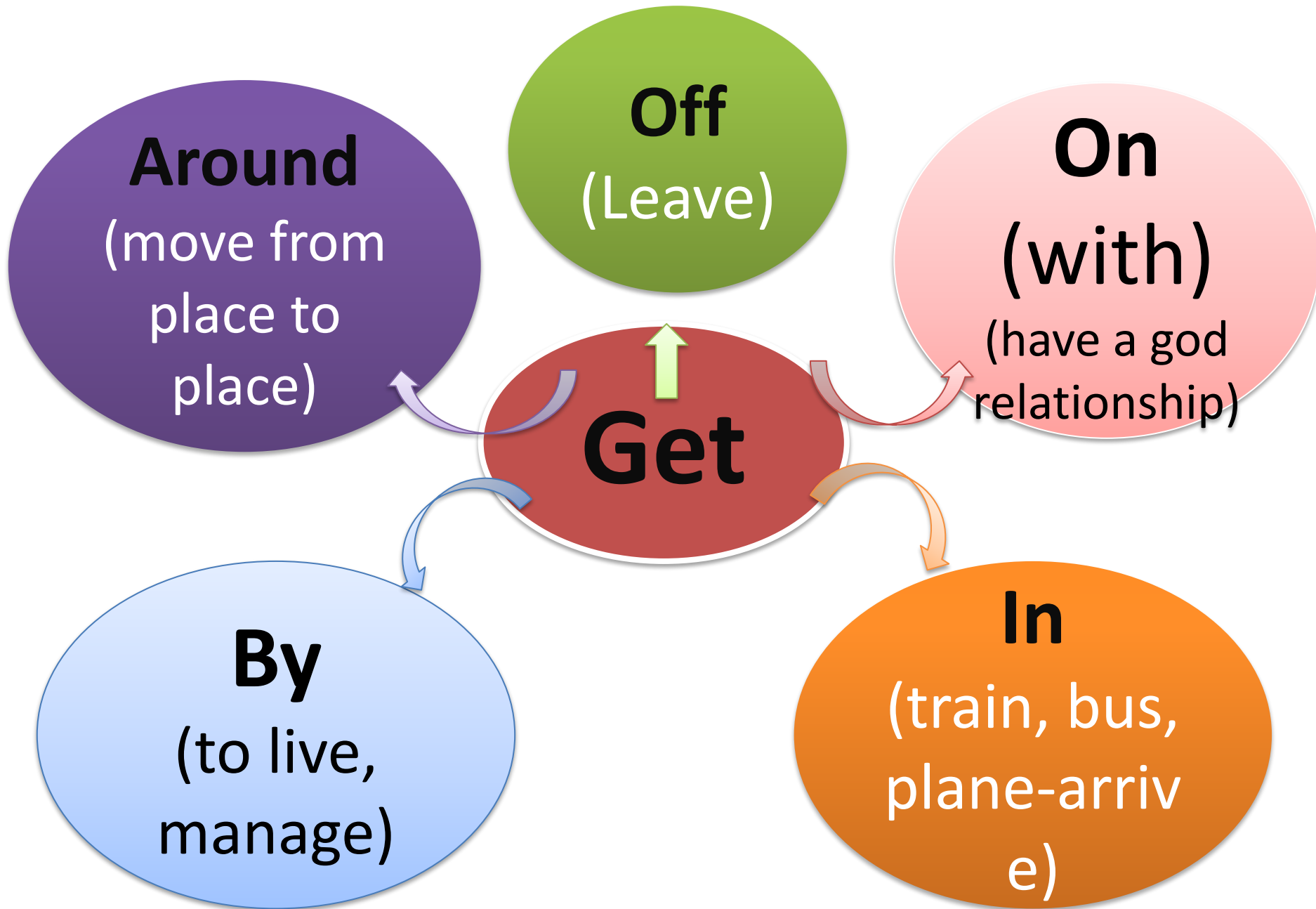
