to look at somebody/something in an angry way

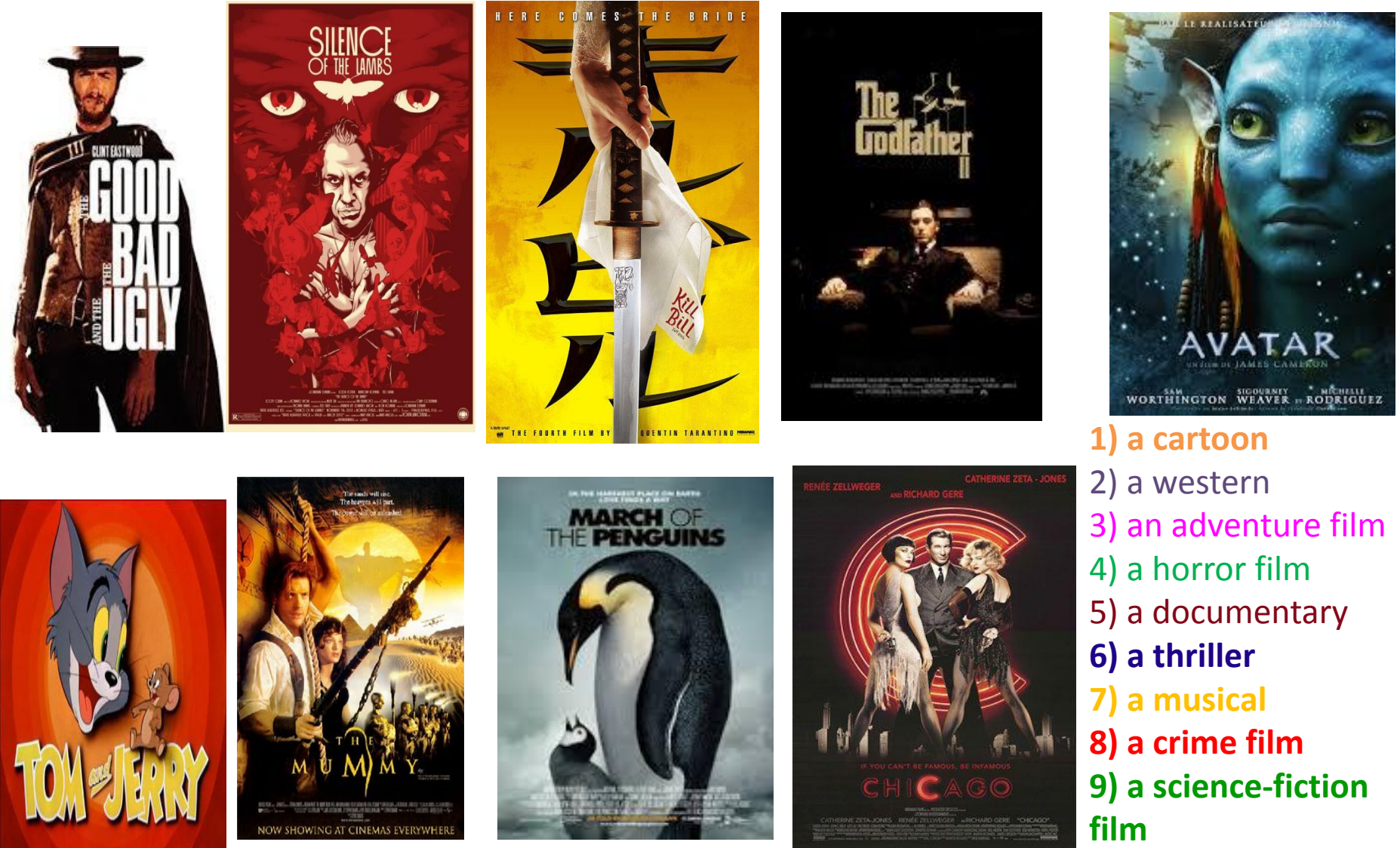
