



Queen Victoria

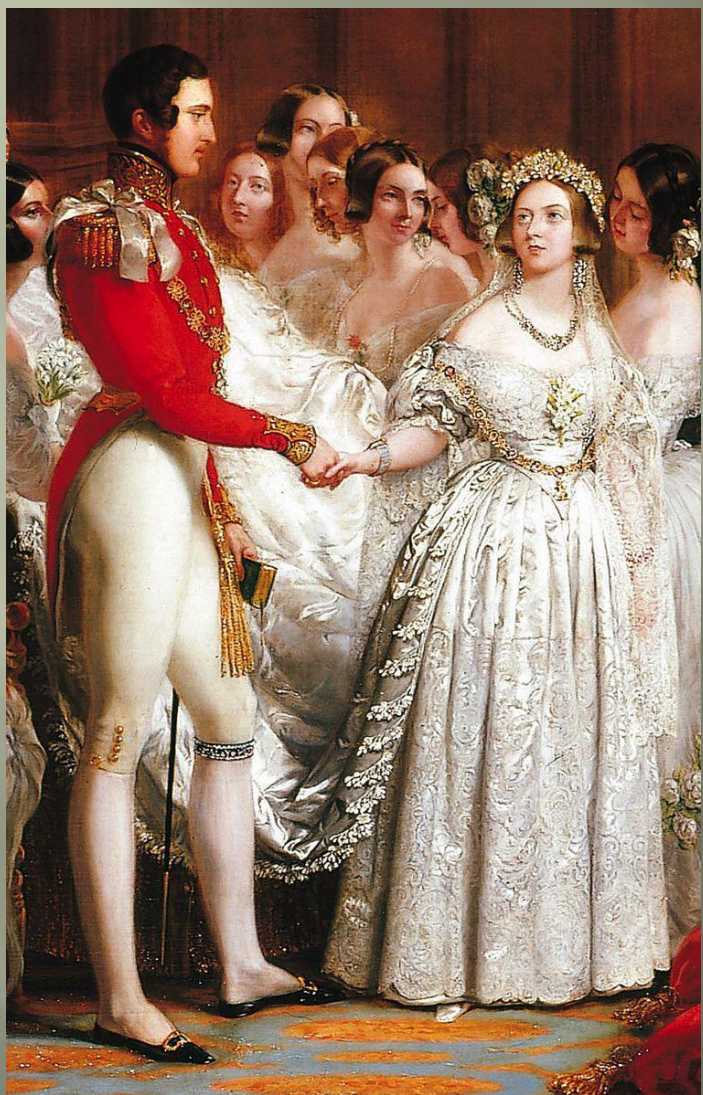
1837- 1901

Victoria, the only child of Prince Edward (Duke of Kent) and Princess Victoria Mary Louisa of Saxe-Coburg-Saalfeld, was born on the 24 May in 1819.



Queen Victoria came to the throne when she was only 18 years of age on June 20, 1837.





At the age of 21, Victoria married her cousin, Albert of Saxe-Coburg Gotha, a German Prince. They married on the 10th February 1840 at the Chapel Royal in St. James's Palace.



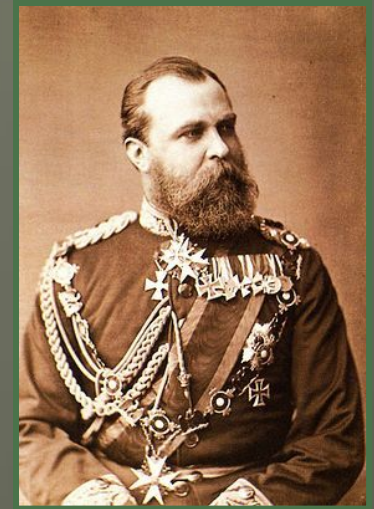
Wedding dress of Queen Victoria was a white. Queen Victoria was the first British ruler who wore a white wedding dress. In the days of Victoria the bride was made to wear dresses of any color, except white

Queen Victoria and Prince Albert had 9 children (4 boys and 5 girls).

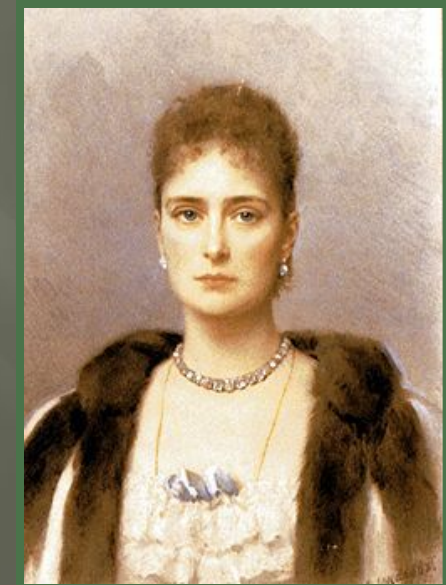




The second daughter of Queen Victoria, Alice Maud Mary, married Louis IV, Grand Duke of Hesse. Their sixth child, Princess Alix Viktoria Helena Luise Beatrice, married Nicholas II and became Tsarina of Russia.



Nicholas became engaged to Alix of Hesse in April 1894.

Prince Albert died in 1861 at the young age of 42. Victoria mourned his death for almost 10 years. For the rest of her reign she wore black.

Whilst Victoria was Queen there was a tremendous change in the lives of British people: Britain became the most powerful country in the world, with the largest empire that had ever existed, ruling a quarter of the world's population.
