• The major sector is the "tertiary sector" in the UK, contributing around 78% of GDP.

 The UK has been the fastest growing economy in the G7 for three consecutive years as at October 2015

The UK was the 9<sup>th</sup> larger exporter and 5<sup>th</sup> larger inporter in the World.

#### **International Relations**

- The United Kingdom remains a major power and a permanent member of the United Nations Security Council.
- They are a Member state of the European Union.
- Founding member of the G7 G8 G20 NATO OECD WTO Council of Europe OSCE.
- Also a member of Commonwealth of Nations.


