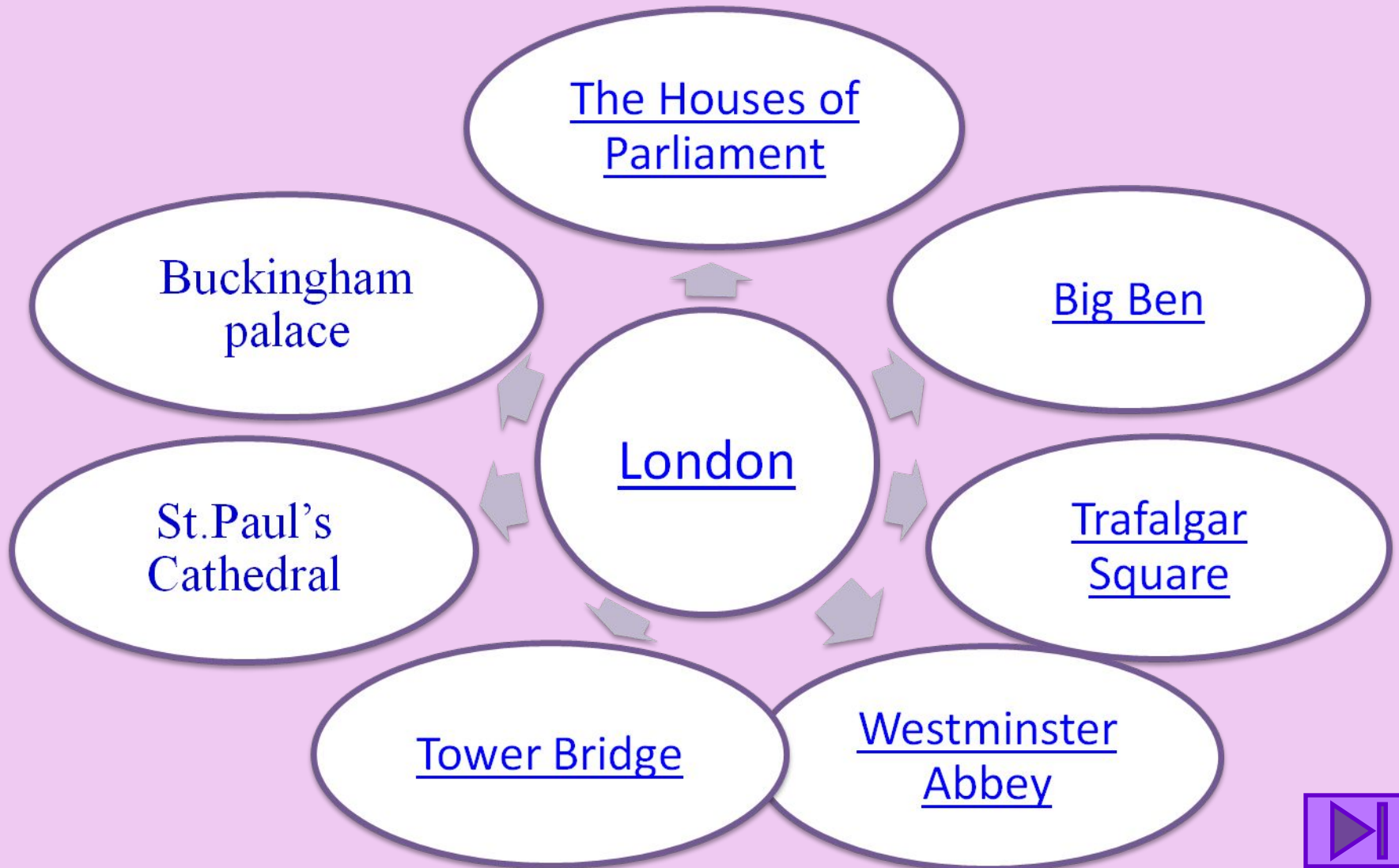

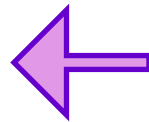

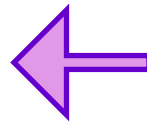
London is the capital of the UK. It is a beautiful city. London is a city of history and museums.



The Houses of Parliament



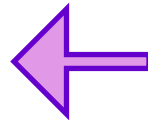
Look at the Houses of Parliament on the river Thames. They are very old. There was a palace there, and now it is the home of the British Parliament.

Trafalgar Square



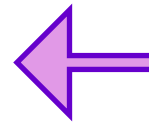
Look at Trafalgar Square.

Westminster Abbey



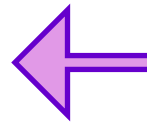
Look at Westminster Abbey. It is the political centre of London.

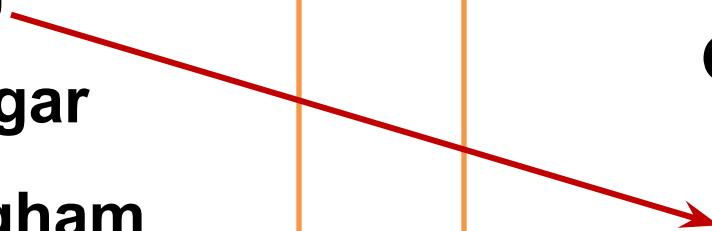
