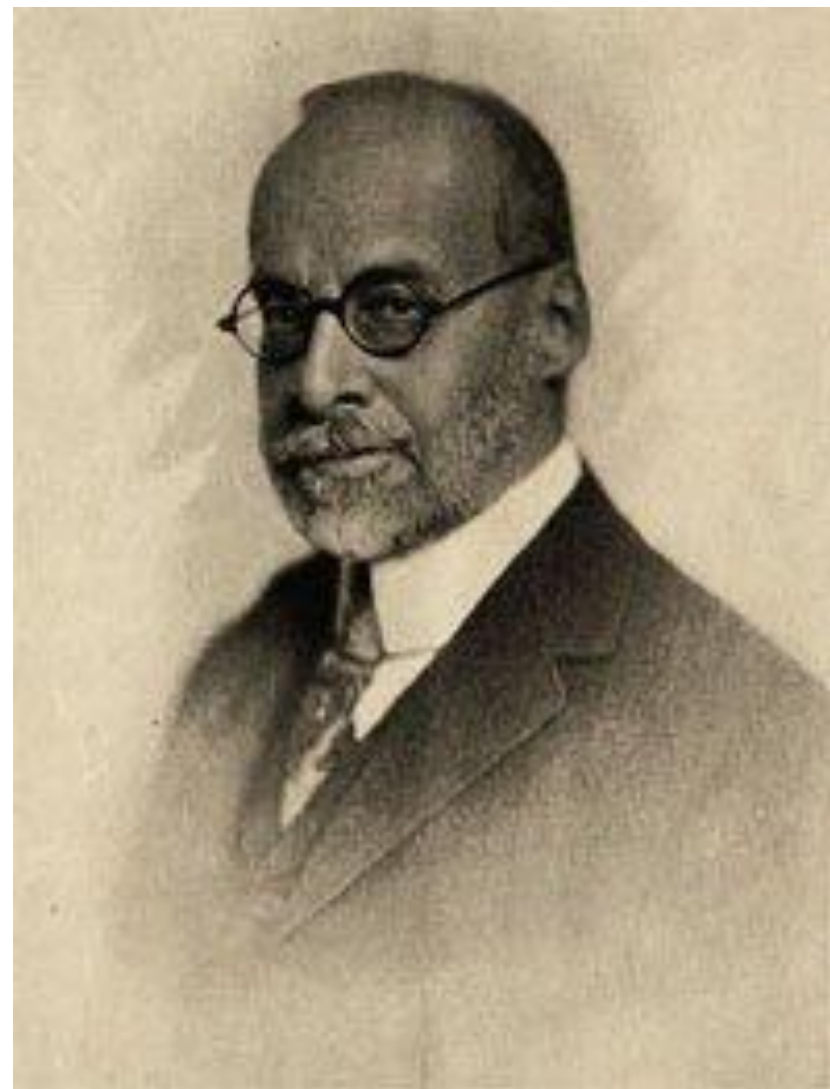

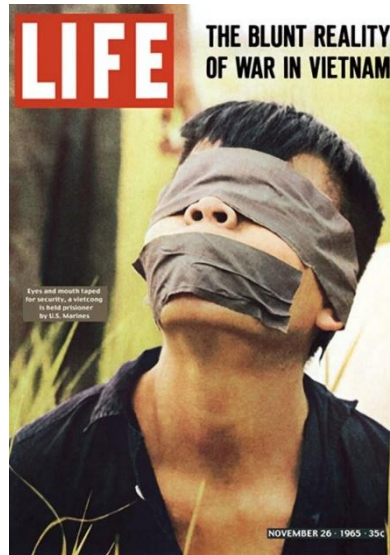
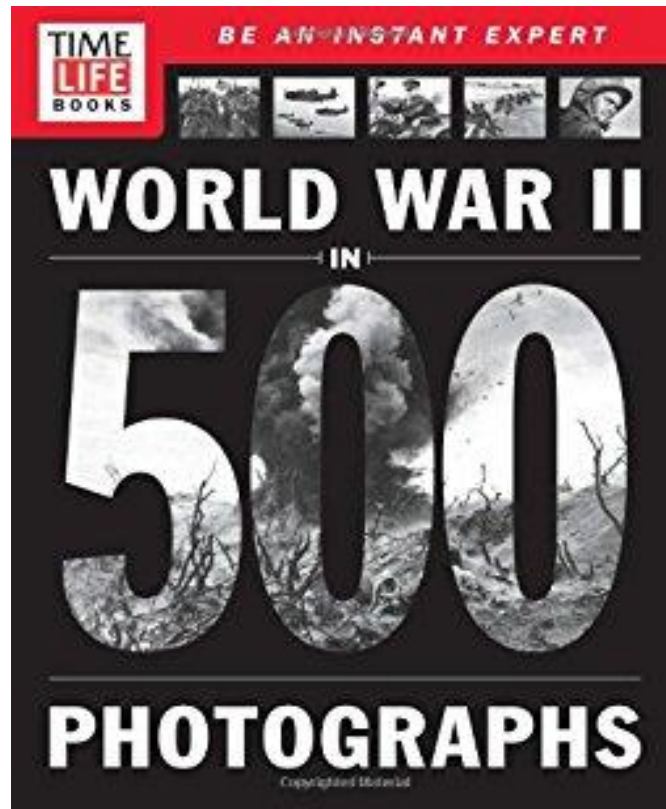

THEY'VE BEEN NEARLY 100 YEARS SINCE THE FIRST PHOTOGRAPH WAS TAKEN

The first photograph was taken in 1826 by Nicéphore Niépce, a French inventor and inventor of the first camera. The photograph, known as 'View from the Window at Le Gras', is a very faint and blurry image of rooftops in France. It was the beginning of a new era in photography and art.
