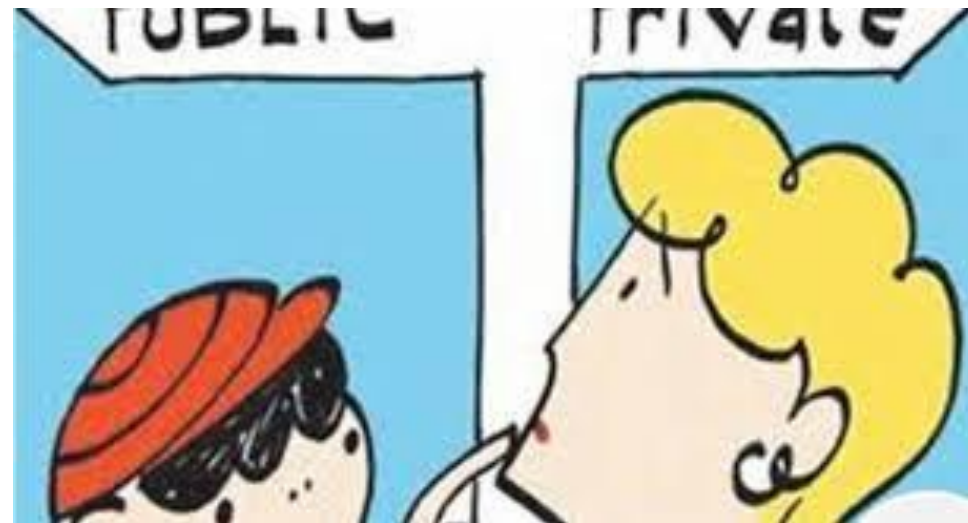


COMMERCIAL LAW



PRIVATE AND PUBLIC LAW

- Commercial law is a general term for a number of diverse areas of the law which regulate trade and commerce.
- Commercial law developed as a distinct body of jurisprudence with the beginning of large-scale trade, and many of its rules are derived from the practices of traders.

- Non-contentious work

Involves the consequences of breach of contract.

- Contentious work
