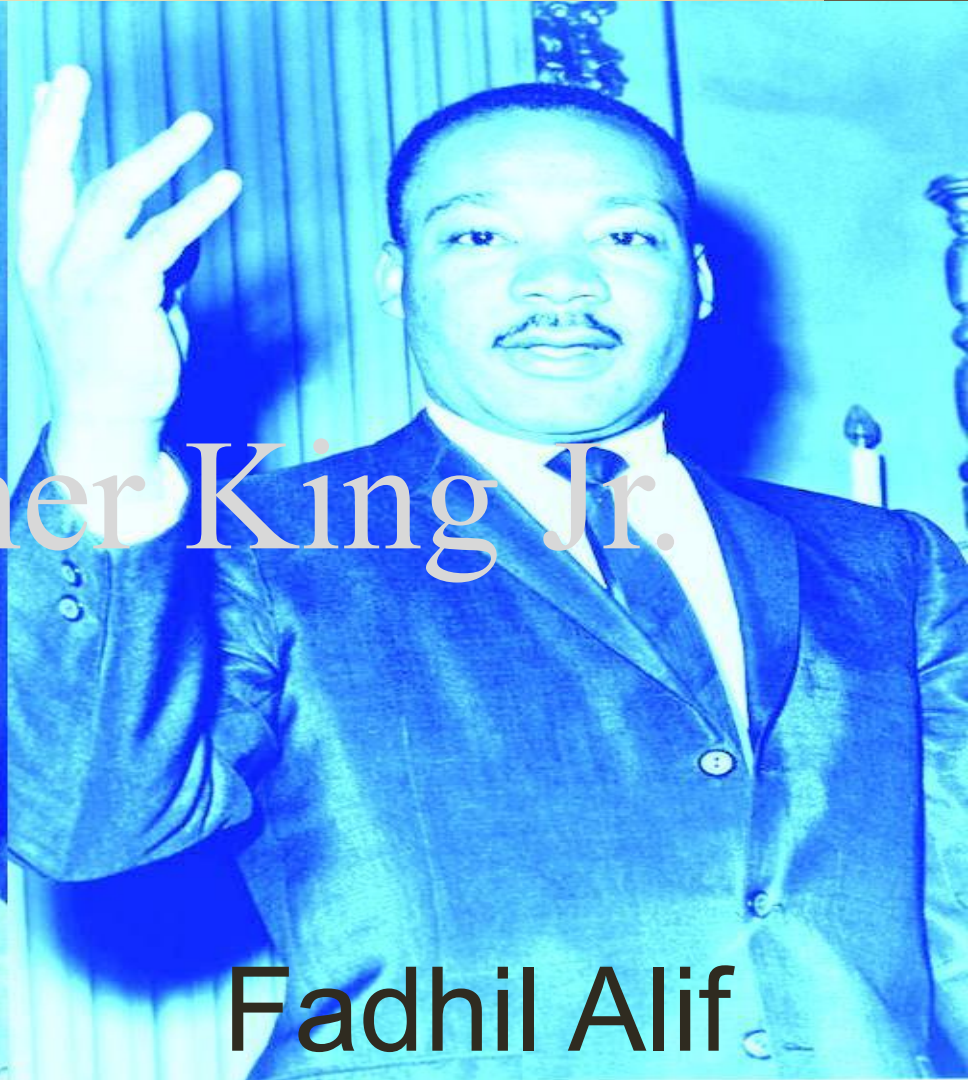

(January 15, 1929 – April 4, 1968)

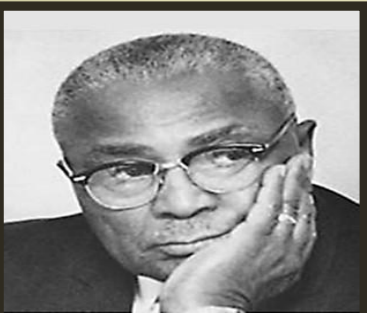
was an,

- Married **Coretta Scott**, the younger daughter of Obadiah and Bernice McMurry Scott of Marion, Alabama, on June 18, 1953.



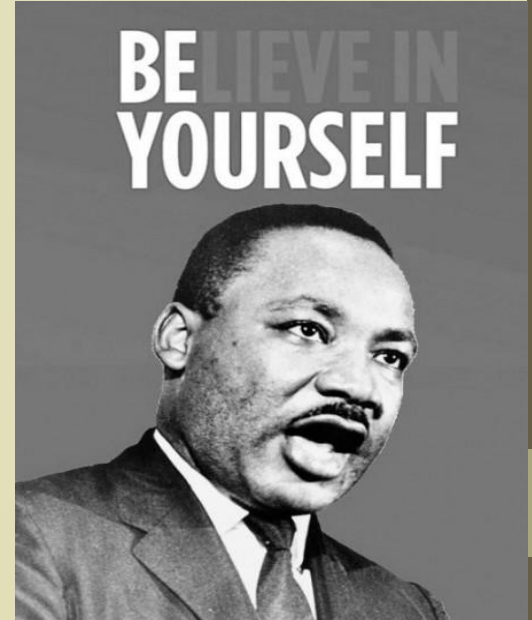
Four children were born to Dr. and Mrs. King:

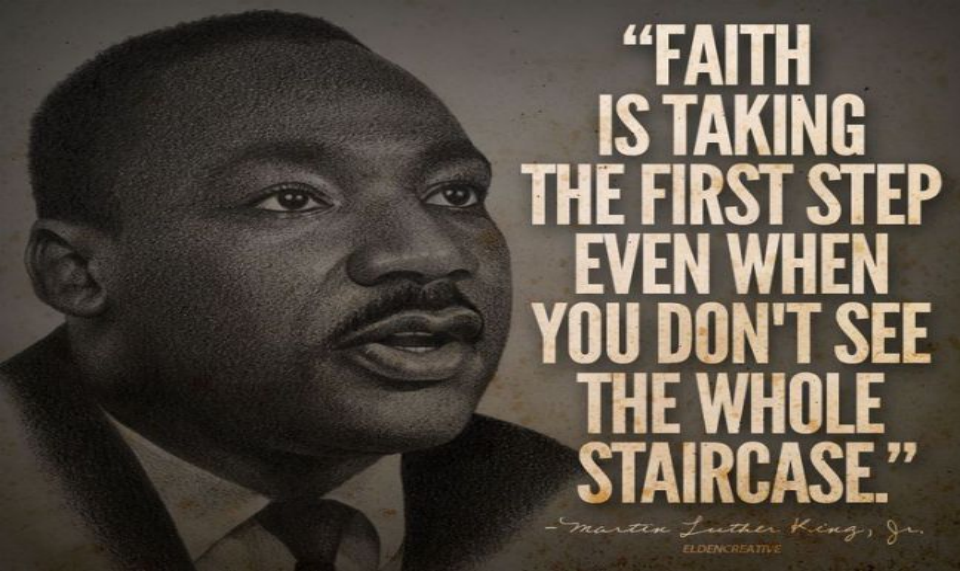
- Yolanda Denise (November 17, 1955, Montgomery, Alabama)

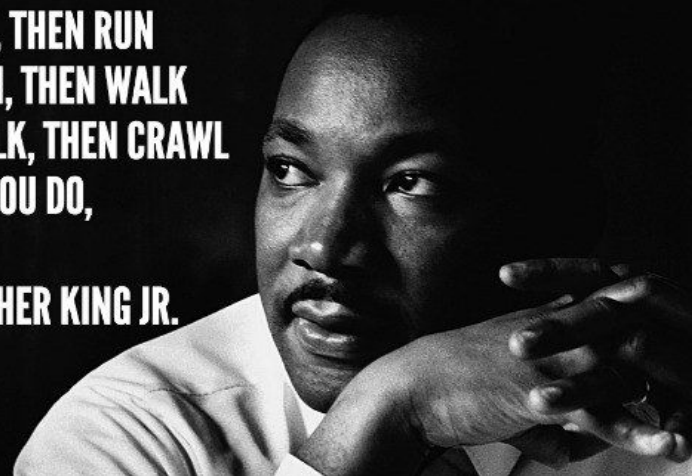

MLK Birthday As a National Holiday

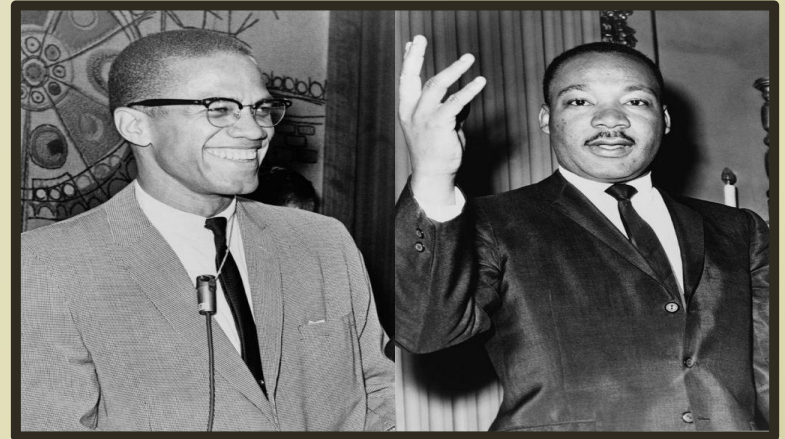
- African-American Congressman John Conyers, introduced a bill to honour King's legacy by making his birthday a national holiday.

- President Ronald Reagan signed bill into law in November, 1983.





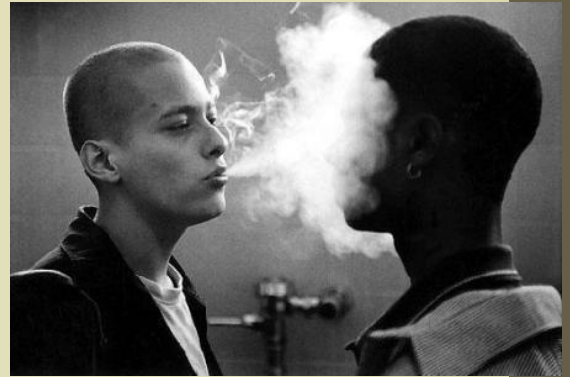
- He had the rap sheets of the career criminal.
