Victoria's mother and Sir John Conroy elaborated a set of rules, so called "Kensington System" that practically insulated little Victoria from people.

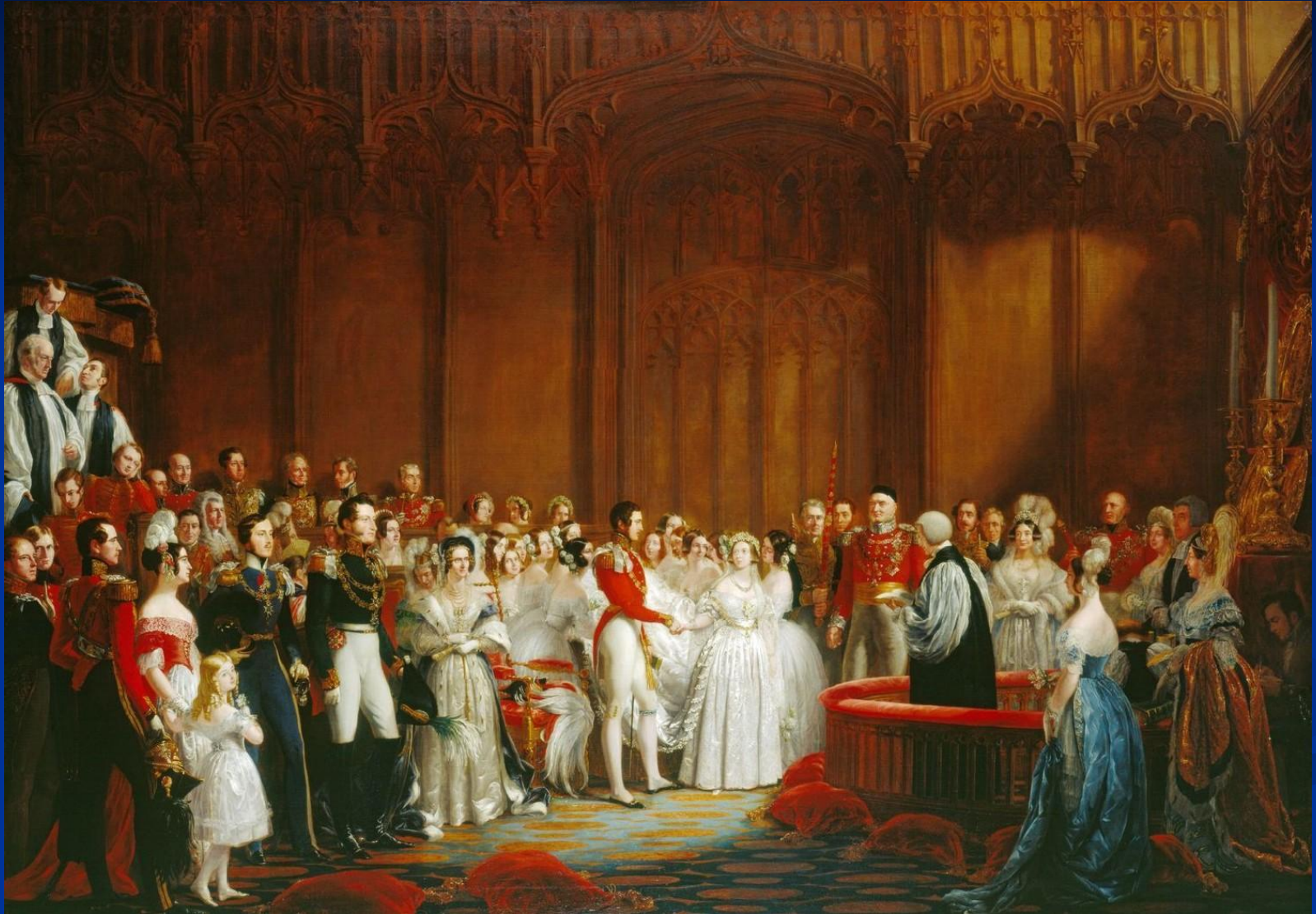
Accession: 28 June 1838
