"A good science-fiction story is a story about human beings, with a human problem, and a human solution, which would not have happened at all without its science content"

"A form of fiction that draws imaginatively on scientific knowledge and speculation in its plot, setting, theme, etc."

What is Science Fiction?

- Science fiction is a writing style which combines science and fiction.
- It is only limited by what we presently know about the basic physical laws of nature.
- Science fiction stories contain some or all of the following elements:
 - Time or Space Travel
 - Advanced Technology
 - Futuristic Setting
 - Parallel Universe /Society

Writers take Scientific Possibilities and develop them step-by-step <u>from known</u> <u>data</u> to form a story.

Science Fiction VS. Fantasy
