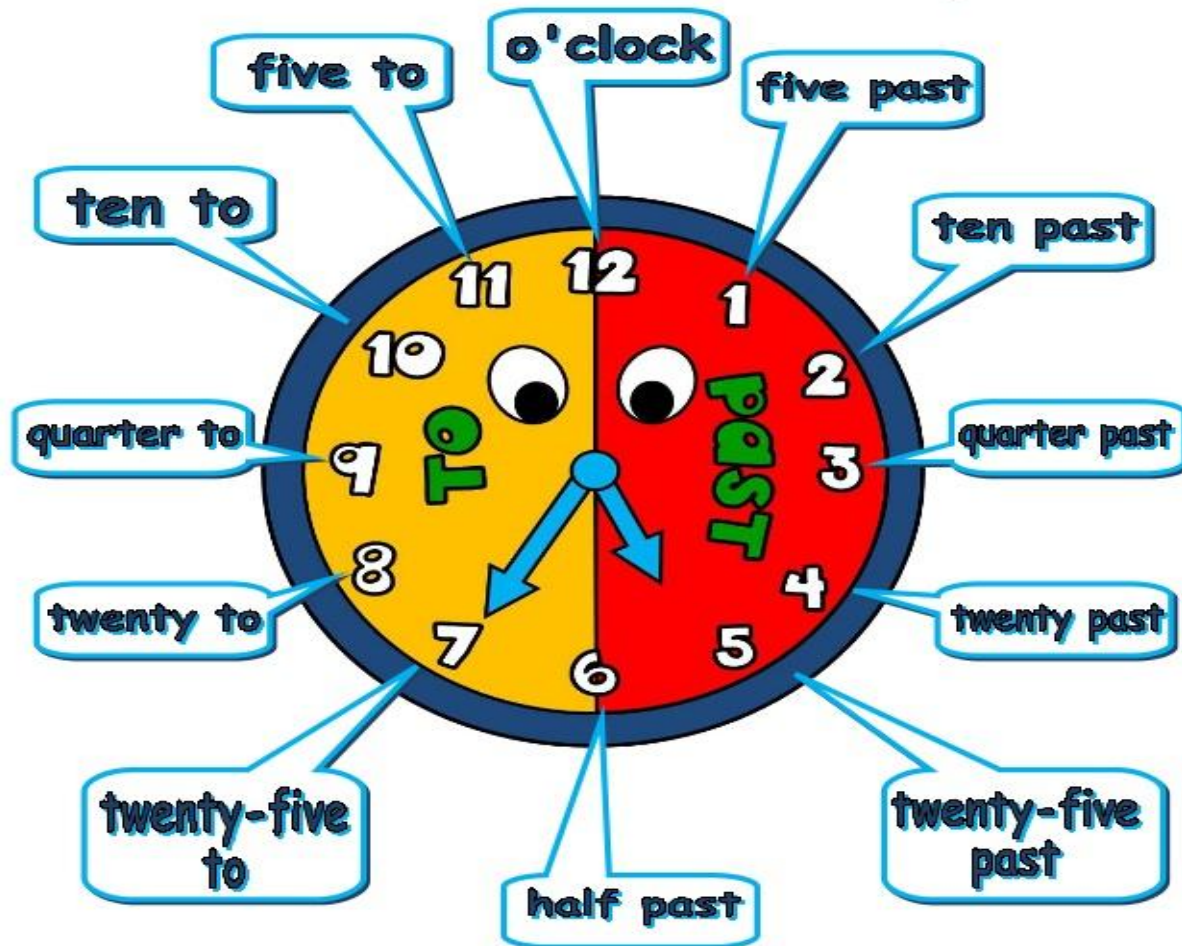

**a.m.** → Latin - ante meridiem = **before noon**

**p.m.** → Latin - post meridiem = **after noon**


It is the season of the year in which Christmas is celebrated.

**SNOW**



**SNOWMAN**



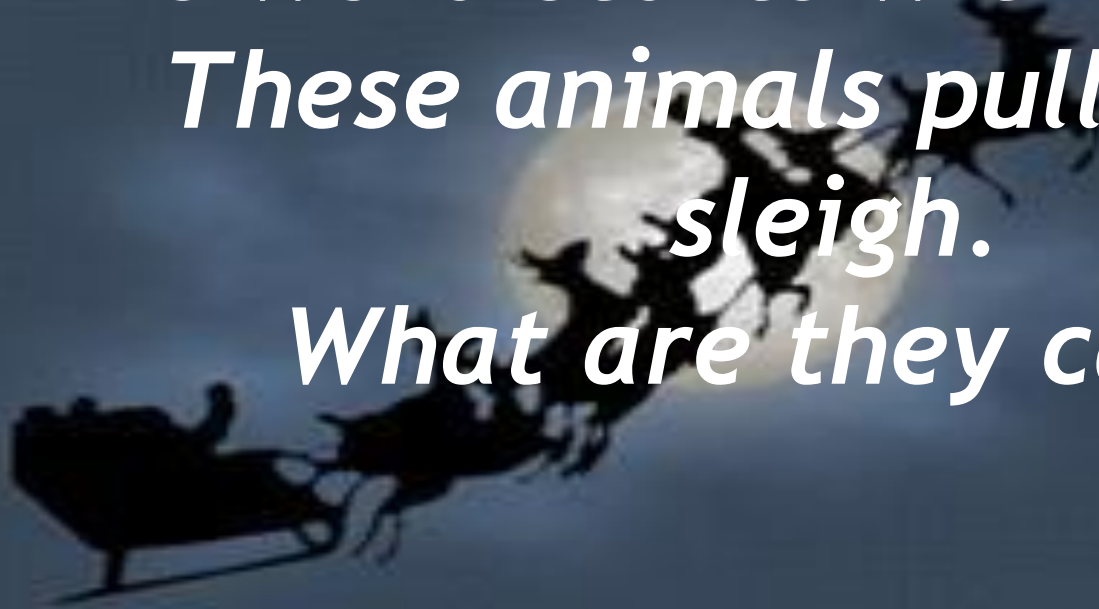
