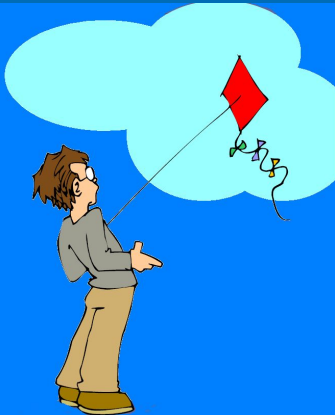

## Negation (-) to be

• I was n't married

• We were n't friends

You were n't ill

They were n't in London

• She was n't a pupil

He was n't at school

It was n't cold



# Negation (-) other verbs

I **didn't** like **d** chocolate

We **didn't** play **ed** football yesterday

You **didn't** travel **ed** last summer

They **didn't** **read** many books

She **didn't** listen **ed** to music

He **didn't** **wgot** abroad

It **didn't** become cold

**Yes / No questions (?) – to be**

**They were in the country yesterday.**

- **Were they in the country yesterday?** -Yes, they were.
- No, they weren't.

**She was in Moscow last weekend.**

- **Was she in Moscow last weekend?** -Yes, she was.
- No, she wasn't.

**It was very cold two days ago.**

- **Was it cold two days ago?** -Yes, it was.
- No, it wasn't.

# Yes / No questions (?) - other verbs

I like **d** chocolate

We play **ed** football yesterday

You travel **ed** last summer

**Did**

They **read** many books

?

She listen **ed** to music

He **went** abroad

It become **ed** cold

- Did you play tennis on Monday?
- Yes, I did. I always play tennis on Monday.
- No, I didn't. I never play tennis.
- Did they go to Ann's party?
- Yes, they did. They went to Ann's party.
- No, they didn't. They didn't know about it.
- Did she give him a telephone number?
- Yes, she did. She liked that boy very much.
- No, she didn't. She has a boyfriend.
