## Present

It is known [that science affects every sphere of human life (object subordinate clause)].

Science is known [to affect ](simple infinitive) every sphere of human life.

subject predicate object

## **Present + continuous aspect**

#### <u>It seems</u>, <u>she is sleeping</u> now.

### **<u>She</u>** <u>seems</u> [to be sleeping] (continuous infinitive) now.

## Past

#### **<u>It appears</u>**, **<u>they lost interest</u>** in this journey altogether.

#### **They** appear [to have lost ](perfect infinitive) interest.

## **Past + continuous aspect**

It is likely that the professor was working in the lab when our rector arrived.

**The professor** is likely [to have been working] in the lab...
