



TOOLS



AWL

Is used to punch holes in leather, wood and other materials



AXE

Is used to cut, chop or split wood, ropes etc.



BOLT

Is used to fasten objects
together



BRUSH

Is used for painting

BUCKET and MOP

Are used to swab decks



CANS of PAINT



CHIPPING HAMMER

Is used to chip off rust



CHISEL

Is used to chip, carve or cut into solid materials, such as wood, stone or metal





CROWBAR

Is used to remove nails.
It can also be used as a lever

DUSTPAN and BROOM

Are used for sweeping





FILE

Is used to remove fine amounts of material (wood, metal) from an object

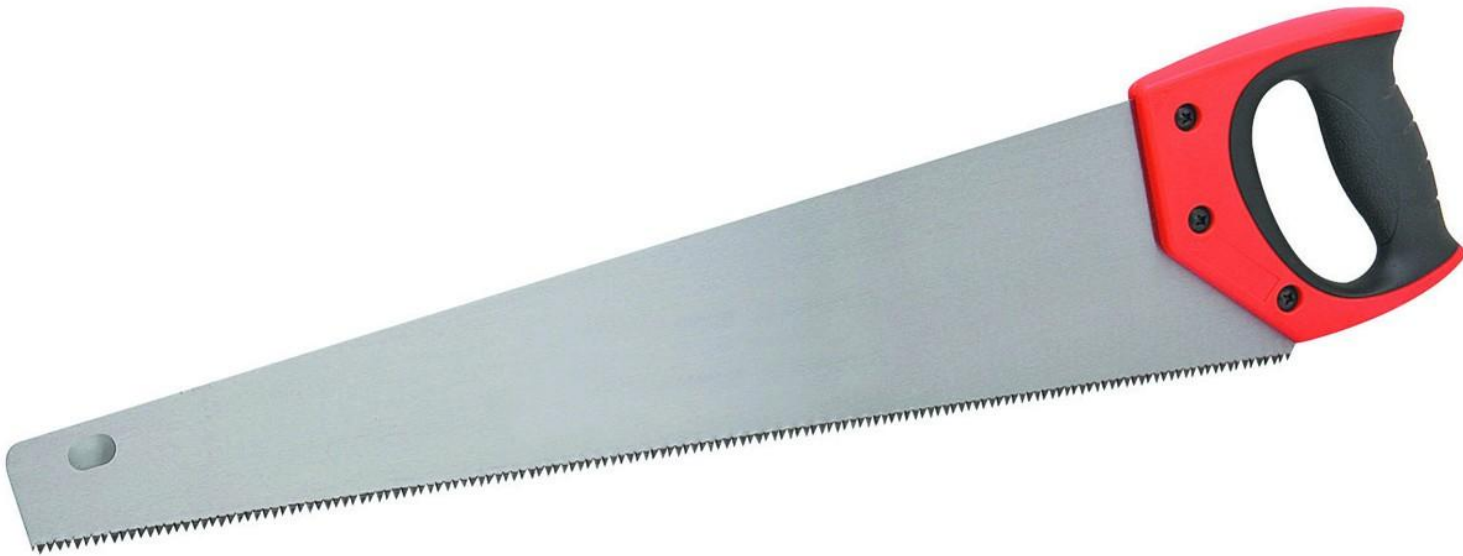
GRINDER



Is used for removing excess material from a piece (polishing)

HANDSAW

Is used for cutting pieces of wood into different shapes





HATCHET

Is used to cut and split wood

INSULATING TAPE



Is used to insulate electrical wires and other materials that conduct electricity



NAIL

Is used in building, fastening or holding separate pieces together

NAIL PULLER

Is used for pulling out nails



NEEDLE SCALER

Is used for cleaning heavy paint
and rust scale from metal
surfaces





NUT

Is used to fasten multiple parts together (in conjunction with a bolt)



PLIERS

Are used for holding objects,
bending and compressing
various materials

PNEUMATIC HAMMER



Is used for chipping rust; most appropriate for flat surfaces



PRIMER

Is used as a preparatory coating put on materials before painting. It ensures better sticking of paint to the surface, increases paint durability, and provides additional protection for the material being painted



PUTTY

Is used to fasten glass and fill cracks in woodwork



ROLLER

Is used for painting



SANDPAPER

Is used to remove material from surfaces, either to make them smoother, to remove a layer of material (such as old paint), or to make the surface rougher



SCISSOR

Are used for Scutting various materials



SCRAPER

Is used to remove loose paint
and scale

SCREW

Is used to fasten objects
together



SCREWDRIVER

s used for turning screws





SHOVEL

Is used to clean the holds

SOLDERING IRON

Is used for joining metallic surfaces by melting





SOLVENT

Is used to thin paint



STEPLADDER

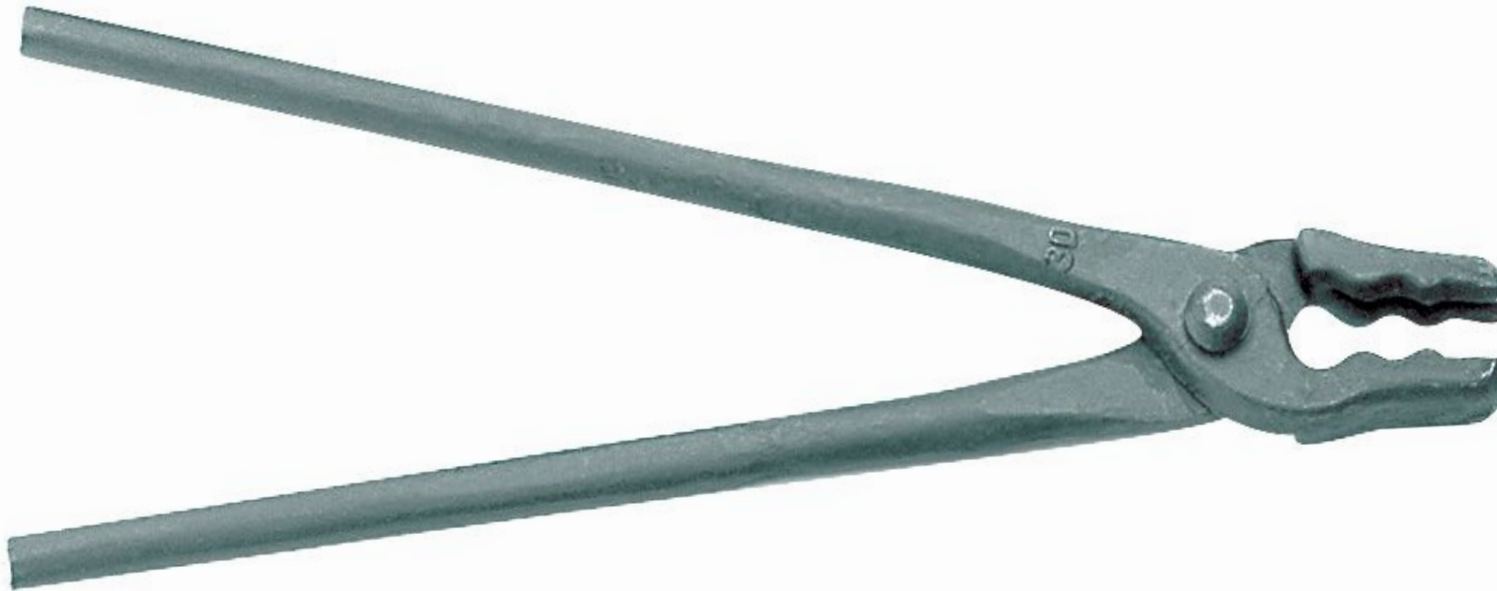
TAPE MEASURE

Is used to measure distance



TONGS

Are used to grip and lift objects



TROWEL

Is used to apply, spread, shape, or smooth loose material





VARNISH

Is applied over wood for gloss and protection

WISE

Is used to secure an object to
allow work to be performed on

WIRE BRUSH

Is used for cleaning rust and removing paint

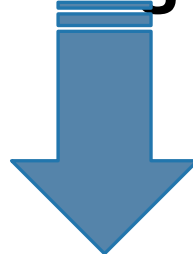
WRENCH (spanner)
