The first vacuum cleaner that used the same principle as those that we use today was invented by Hubert Booth in England in 1901.

 The first ever robotic vacuum cleaner appeared in 1996. It was made by Electrolux, Swedish household and professional appliances manufacturer and was called "Trilobite".
