

Youth Policy in Sweden



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


In Sweden, for example, a National Council of Swedish Youth Organizations, which is the coordinating center for the hundreds of NGOs."



In particular the implementation of its objectives guiding role of the state youth policy is implemented, as experience shows, to a greater extent at the local level. In Sweden, the employment of young people engaged in the municipalities, they also solve the problems of the schools, allocate grants (each year is about 1 million) for the local cultural and youth organizations.








Currently in the field of Social Servicing of the population in the three largest cities in Sweden

The system of social work in Sweden is one of the most committed in Europe. It is based on the principle of everlasting

the value of human life, and its main goal is to create a 21 equitable social structures capable of ensuring the safety of

and human development without compromising his dignity.

Social work in Sweden's system is based on the recognition of

international* legal acts, such as the Universal Declaration of the RightsMan (1948), the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child (1989), the Convention on Protection of Children and Cooperation in Respect ofAdoption (1993), the Declaration on the Protection of Women and Children in Emergency and Armed Conflict (1974

- g), the International Labour Organization and others., regional treaties -European Convention on Human Rights (1950)
 - g), the Helsinki Final Act (1975), the European Social Charter (1961) et al., as well as federal laws, etc.
