Some particles can be used as adjectives in the present and past form

-ING or -ED???

-ING ADJ.

Describe something (object) or someone (person)

- Yesterday I watched an interesting movie / That movie was interesting.
- This teacher is boring / This is a boring teacher.
 -ED ADJ.
- Describe emotions they tell us how people feel about something
- I am interested in history.
- She is bored of that teacher.

Examples: boring or bored

- He talks about football all the time he is boring!
- His football stories are boring.
- I am bored with his football stories.
- When he talks about football I am always bored.
- I had a weekend. I was then.
