ENDING **-ING** and **-ED**

I am interest**ing** or I am interest**ed**

I am bor**ing** or I am bor**ed**

*Some particles can be used as adjectives in
the present and past form*

-ING or -ED???

-ING ADJ.

Describe something (object) or someone (person)

- *Yesterday I watched an interesting movie / That movie was interesting.*
- *This teacher is boring / This is a boring teacher.*

-ED ADJ.

- Describe emotions – they tell us how people feel about something
- *I am interested in history.*
- *She is bored of that teacher.*

Examples: boring or bored

- He talks about football all the time – **he is boring!**
- His football **stories are boring.**
- **I am bored with** his football stories.
- When he talks about football **I am always bored.**
- I had a weekend. I was then.
