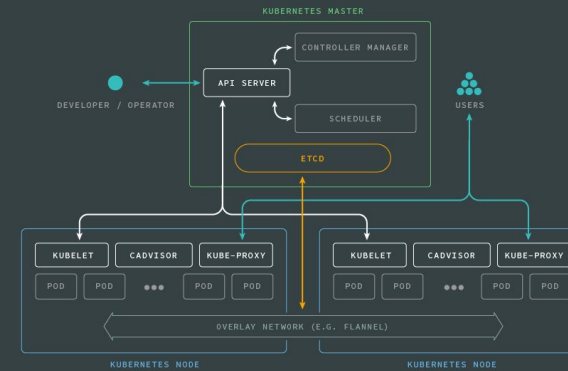

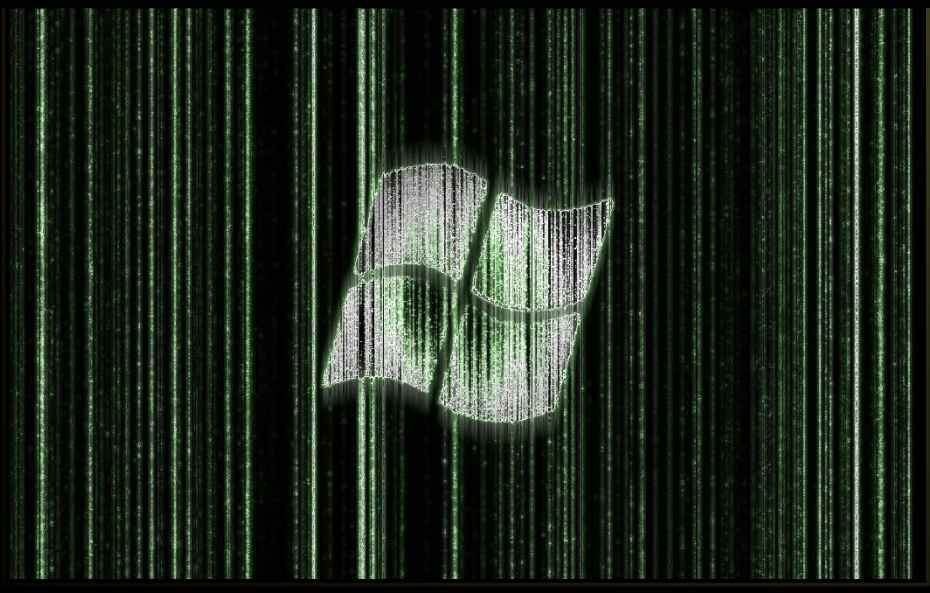

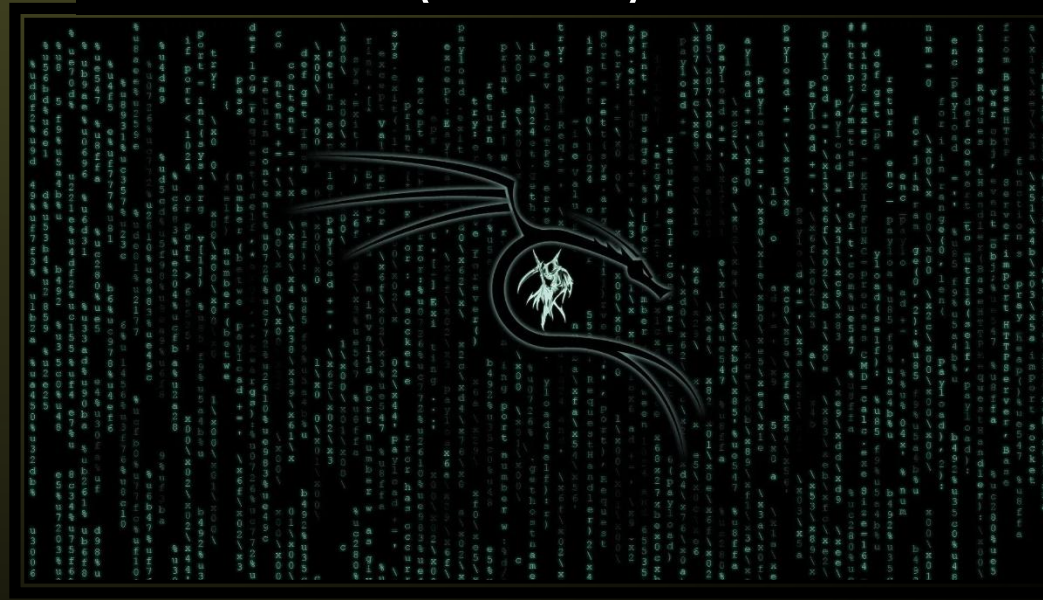
The Kubernetes Control Plane

Kevin Mitnick is the most famous computer hacker, now a writer and information security specialist.

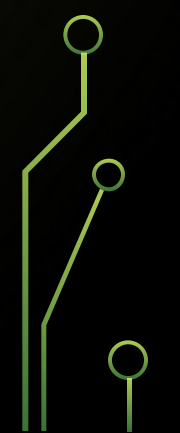

## IDEOLOGUES OF HACKER ETHICS

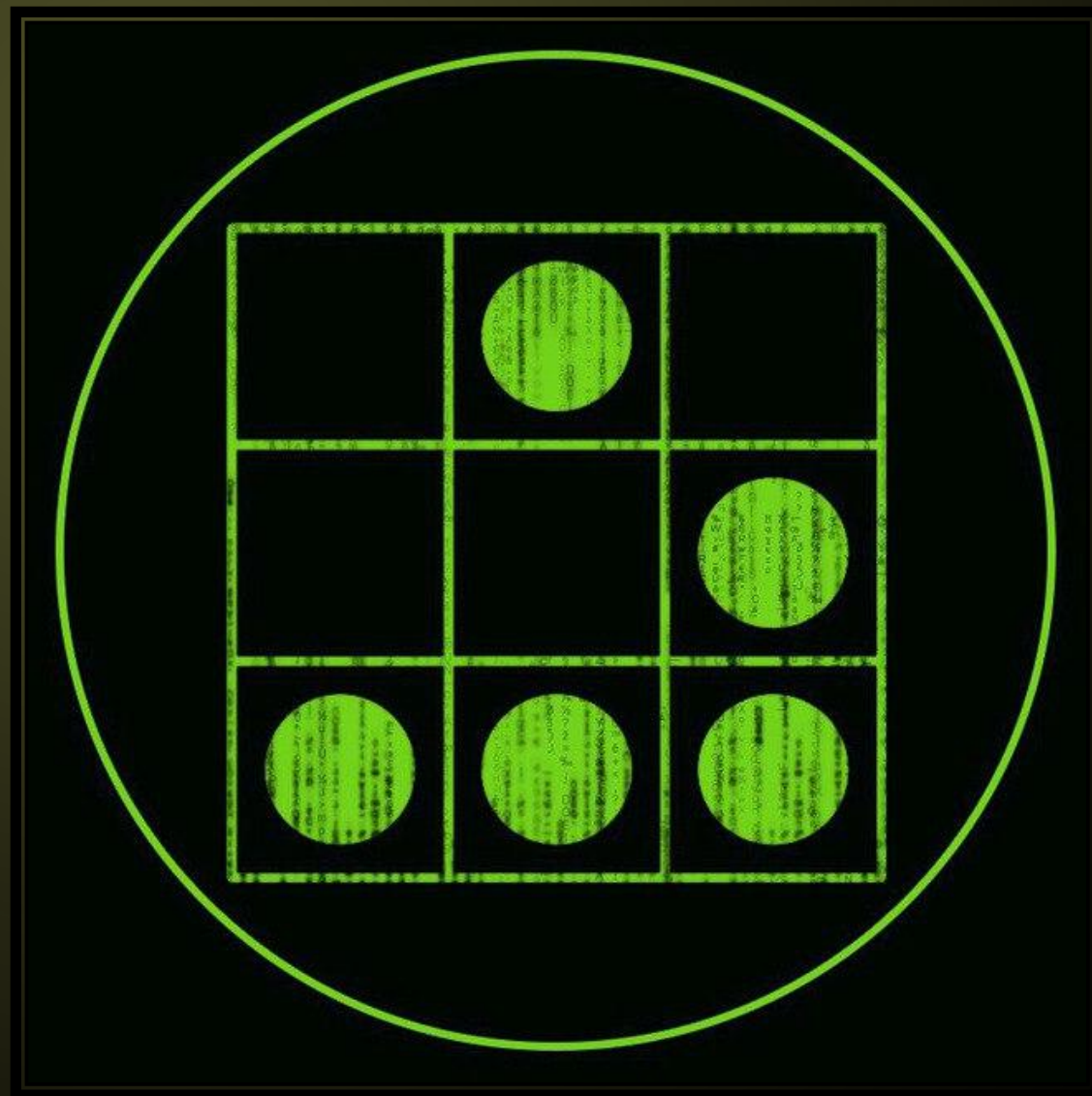
