





Kevin Mitnick is the most famous computer hacker, now a writer and information security specialist. Richard Stallman is the founder of the GNU Project and the FSF.


Eric Raymond is a writer, editor, and curator of the Jargon File, an online encyclopedia of hacker slang and hacker culture.
