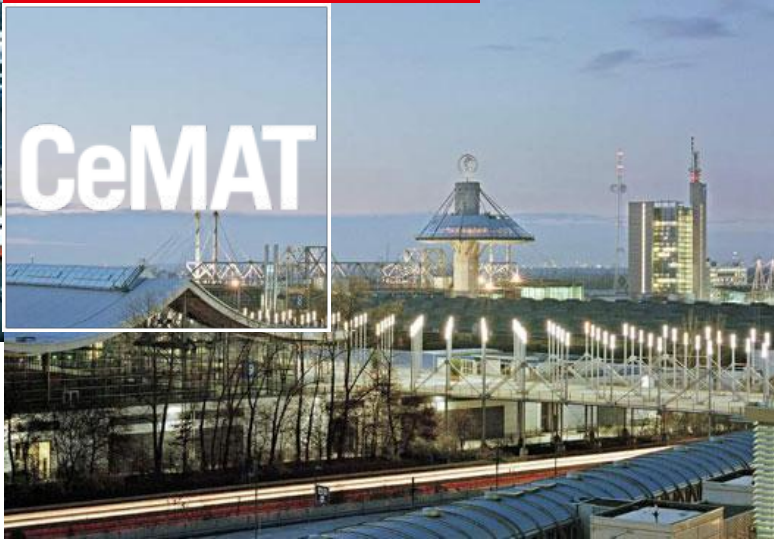

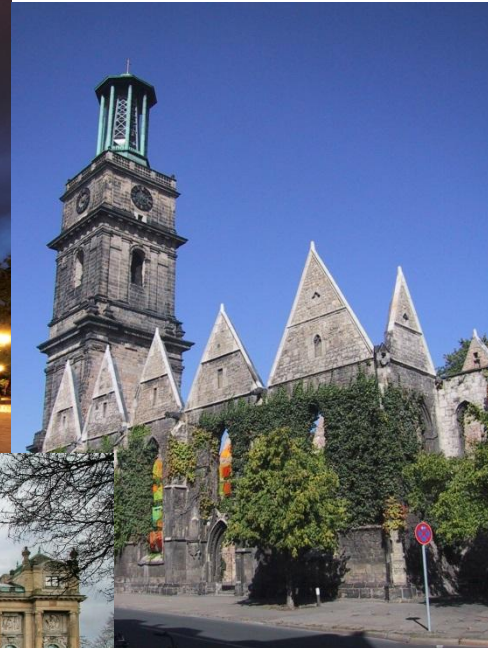
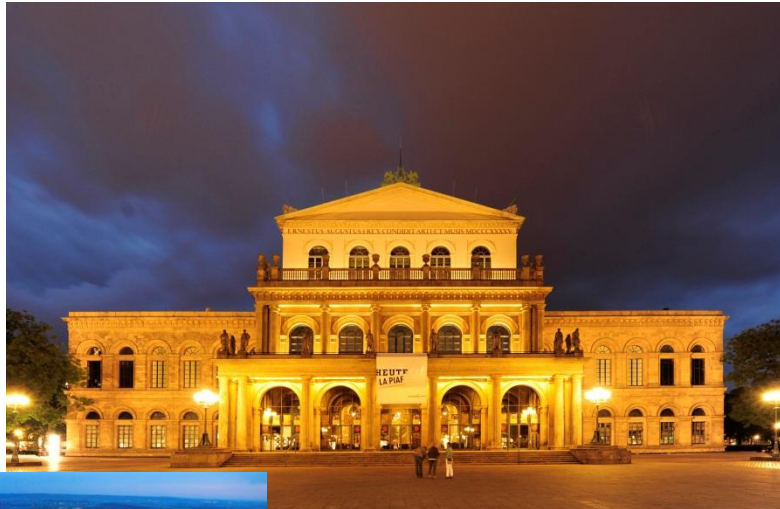

- 2006 Leibniz Universität Hannover



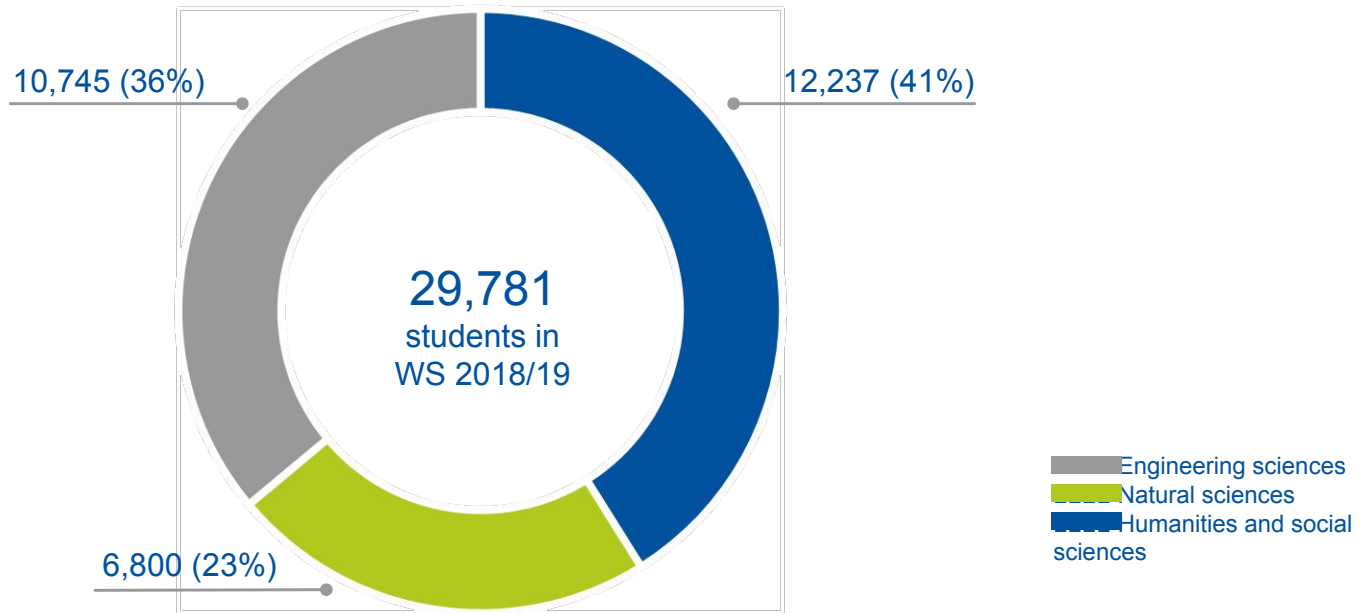

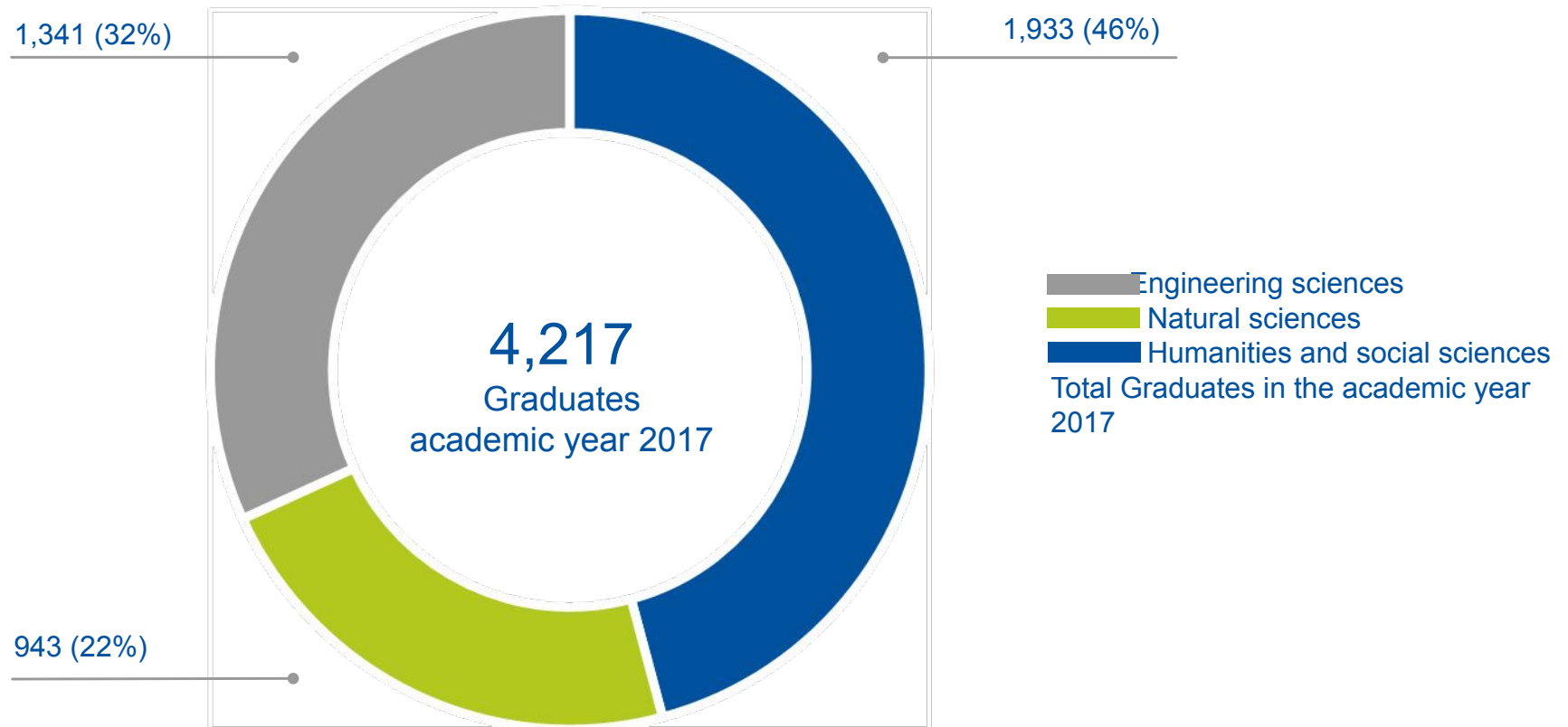

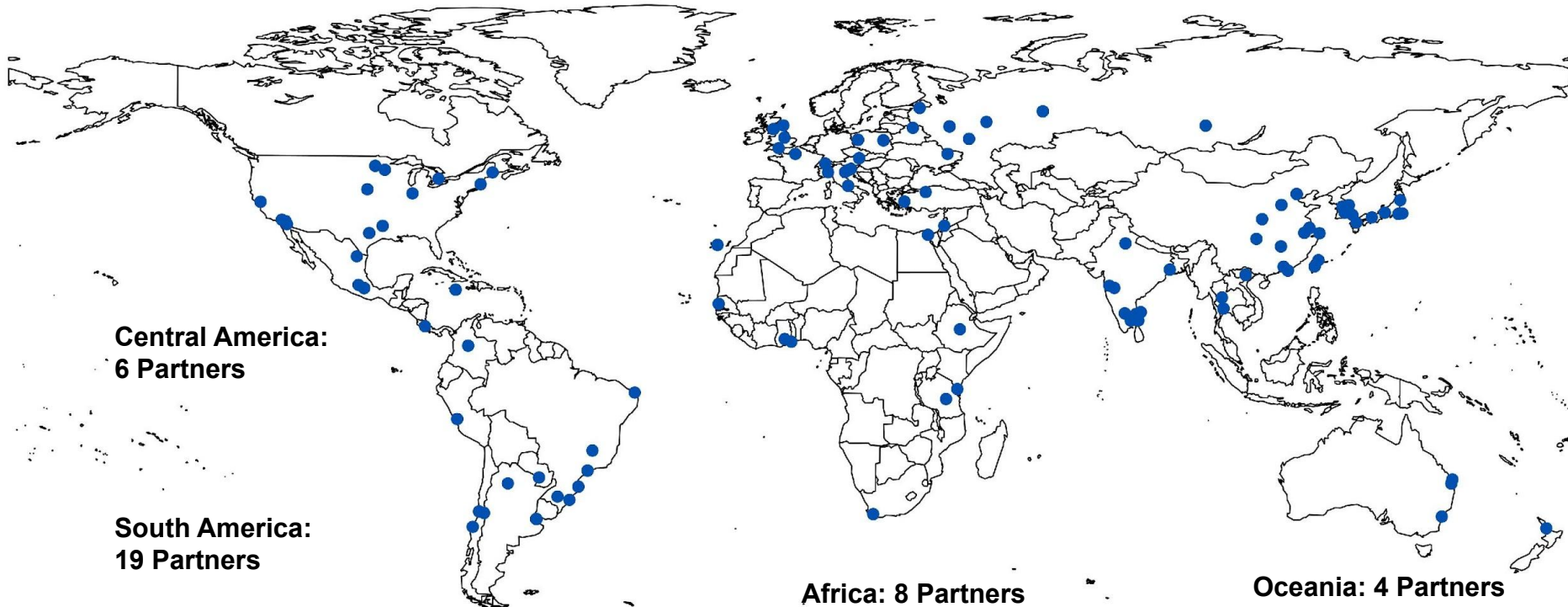

*This is the right place for information and service regarding your studies or research stay at Leibniz Universität Hannover as well as information about opportunities to study or research abroad.*

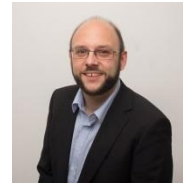
