Christmas is an annual commemoration of the birth of Jesus Christ.





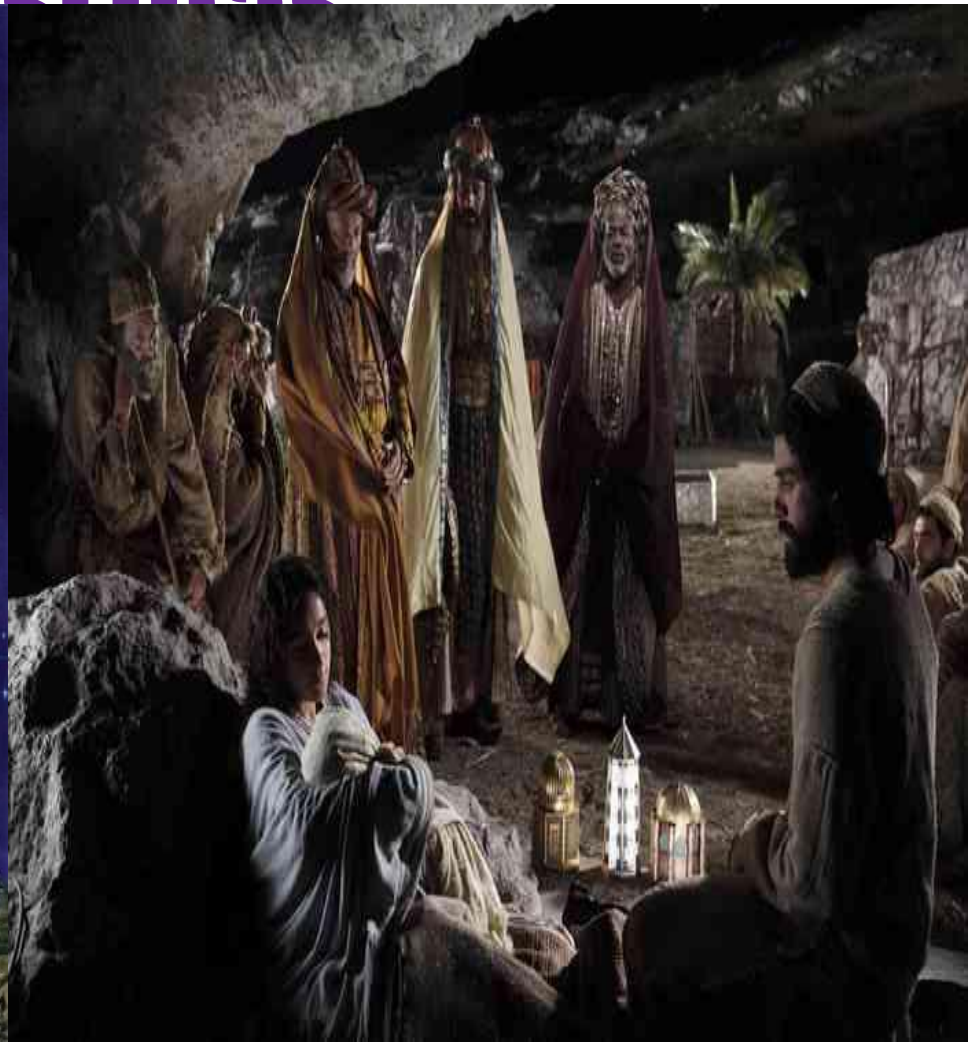
**Christmas story comes from the Bible.**
