A unique city

- 5 boroughs: Manhattan, Brooklyn, Queens, Bronx, Staten Island
- Manhattan 13 miles long and 2 miles wide
- 2 parts the East Side and the West Side
- The dividing line Fifth Avenue





Lower (Downtown) Manhattan

- The Wall Street Area the New York Stock Exchange, the American Stock Exchange
- The Lower East Side elegant district, Irish, Jews, Puerto Ricans and Hispanics
- Little Italy food, Italians
- Chinatown 7 newspapers, 200 restaurants
- The Lower East Side Greenwich Village, Washington Square (street performers, jazz bands, police, drug dealers, joggers, roller skaters)



Midtown

- The 1st skyscraper 1902 20 storied high
- 1920's building boom
- Art deco style the Chrysler Building and the Empire State Building
- Rockefeller Centre 1930's
- 1950's steel and glass the United Nations Secretariat
- Times Square main offices of newspapers
- The Theatre District Broadway theatres

Central Park - 1850's - Frederick Law Olmsted

The Eastern side - Museum Mile -

The Western side - the Dakota

Harlem - inhabited by black population
