# «High Tea»



- Tea means two things. It is a drink and a meal. Some people have afternoon tea, so called «high tea» with sandwiches, tomatoes and salad, pears or pineapples and cakes. That is what they call good tea. It is a substantial meal.



Tea-time is a small meal eaten in the late afternoon (usually between about 3:30 and 5:00). Occasionally people may have a full afternoon tea or a cream tea: this includes a scone with jam and cream (usually either whipped cream or thick clotted cream).
