


TELLING THE TIME



Let's look at the clock face.



minute
hand

hour
hand



What time is

**WHAT IS
THE TIME?**



When the **minute hand** is on 12, read the time as "o'clock".





WHAT TIME IS IT?




It's eight o'clock.

What is the
time?



**It's twelve
o'clock.**

What time is it?



It's three o'clock.

When the minute hand is on 9,
we say “a quarter to”.



It's quarter **to
eleven.**




What is the
time?




It's a quarter
to one.

When the minute hand is on 3, we say "a quarter past".



It's a quarter
past two.

What time is it?



It's a quarter
past twelve.

When the minute hand is on 6,
read the time as “half past”.



It's half
past five.







It's half **past** nine.


**It 's seven

It's time to wake





**It 's a quarter past
