Birthplace of the famous doctor in Moscow.

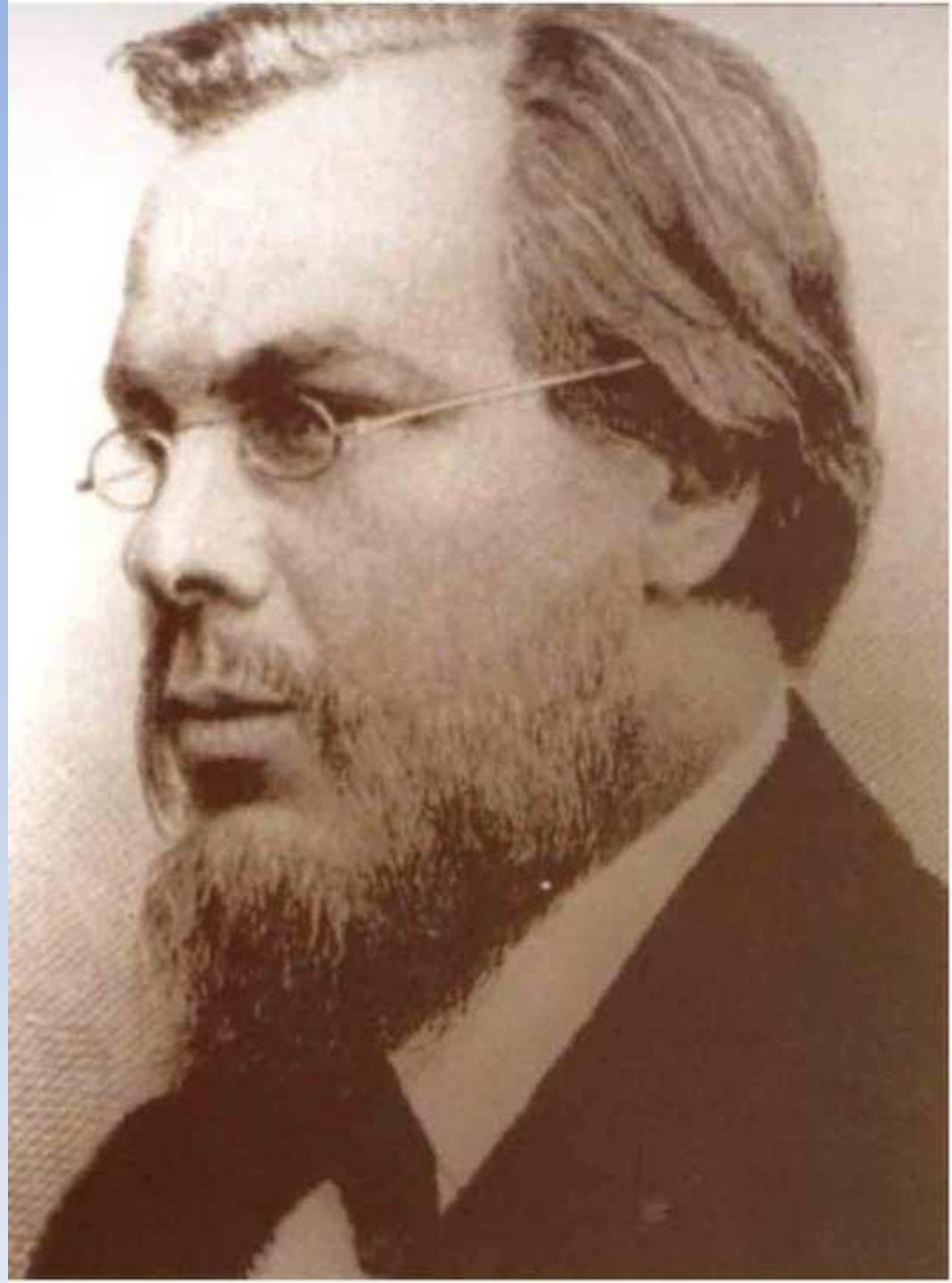
His father was a merchant and engaged in trade in tea. In the family, he was the eleventh child.

In the childhood he wanted to become a mathematician, but by the time of admission to the university issued a decree of the Emperor Nicholas,

which allowed free access to nedvoryan only medical school. He studied at the medical faculty of Moscow University.

Botkin was invited to St. Petersburg Medical-Surgical Academy. The following year he defended his thesis on "The absorption of fat in the intestines." At 29 years, he was promoted to professor.

Widely used in the practice laboratory tests (biochemical, microbiological); to take temperature, auscultation, percussion, examination of the patient.



He first suggested the structure of the protein in various organs; first pointed out that catarrhal jaundice, which Virchow treated as a "mechanical" refers to infectious diseases. Currently, the disease is referred to as "Botkin's disease."
