

THE SAHARA DESERT



THE SAHARA DESERT IS ONE OF THE LARGEST DESERTS IN THE WORLD. IT IS LOCATED IN THE NORTH OF THE AFRICAN CONTINENT.



A YEAR IN THE DESERT CAN FALL LESS THAN 20 MILLIMETERS OF PRECIPITATION. BUT, DESPITE THE FACT THAT RAINS MAY NOT FALL OUT FOR SEVERAL YEARS IN A ROW, SOMETIMES THERE CAN BE A SHOWER LASTING SEVERAL DAYS.



SAHARA DESERT ONLY SEEMS COMPLETELY DESERTED. IN FACT, ITS TERRITORY IS GROWING ABOUT 500 SPECIES OF PLANTS AND LIVES A CONSIDERABLE NUMBER OF ANIMALS. FROM DOMESTIC ANIMALS YOU CAN MEET CAMELS AND GOATS. AND FROM WILD ANIMALS - CHEETAHS, ANTELOPES, FOXES, HYENAS, SNAKES, LIZARDS, LIZARDS AND SOME SPECIES OF BIRDS.
