## Present Perfect

**have/has + verb 3 (participle)**

Happened in the past until present  
(effect or event)

He has drunk all of the milk. We need  
to buy some more for tomorrow

He has waited for your for a long  
time. Go and meet him for once

## Past Tense

**Verb 2**

Happened in the past, ended in the  
past

He drank all of the milk this morning.  
Thus, he often went to toilet.

He waited for two hours, then he left.

**We saw a concert when we went to London.**

She \_\_\_\_\_ (not ride) her bike since the accident.

**She has not ridden her bike since the accident.**

She \_\_\_\_\_ (ride) her bike alone when the accident \_\_\_\_\_  
(happen).

**She rode her bike alone when the accident happened.**
