You will go to school.
L'Il post the letters tomorrow
morning.

Negative



will not / won't + V1

She will not go to work.



Interrogative

Will



V1

Will you sing tonight?

What will you do tomorrow morning?



Use:

For future actions which may or may not happen.

We will visit Disney World one day.







On the spot decisions

□I left the door open. I will close it right now.



What would you like to drink?

I will have a cup of coffee, please.



Did you call Sue? No, I forgot it.

I will call her tonight.

Offer



Don't worry. I'll help you with your homework.

Promise

I will love you forever.

Prediction

You will be rich.



- With the verbs: hope, think, believe, expect
- The expressions: I'm sure, I'm afraid...
- The adverbs: probably, perhaps etc.

I am hungry.

I think I'll have a sandwich.



He <u>will</u> *probably* <u>stay</u> at home.


Time expressions: tomorrow, the day after tomorrow, next week, next year, tonight, soon, in a week/year etc.
