




Ant Life Cycle

Only the winged Princess and Drone ants within a colony will mate. They do this in the air, and the Drones die after mating. The Princess then becomes a Queen and lays tiny eggs in a nest.



Larvae will hatch from the eggs. They look similar to maggots.





Once grown in size, the larvae will spin a silk cocoon around themselves called a Pupa. The change inside the Pupa is called Metamorphosis.



Most ants that emerge from pupas will be worker ants.


Occasionally a young ant will be fed more than the others which means that they could possibly become either a Princess or a Drone.






