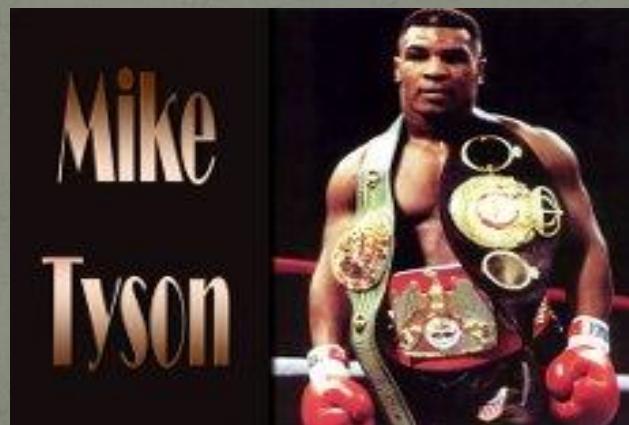

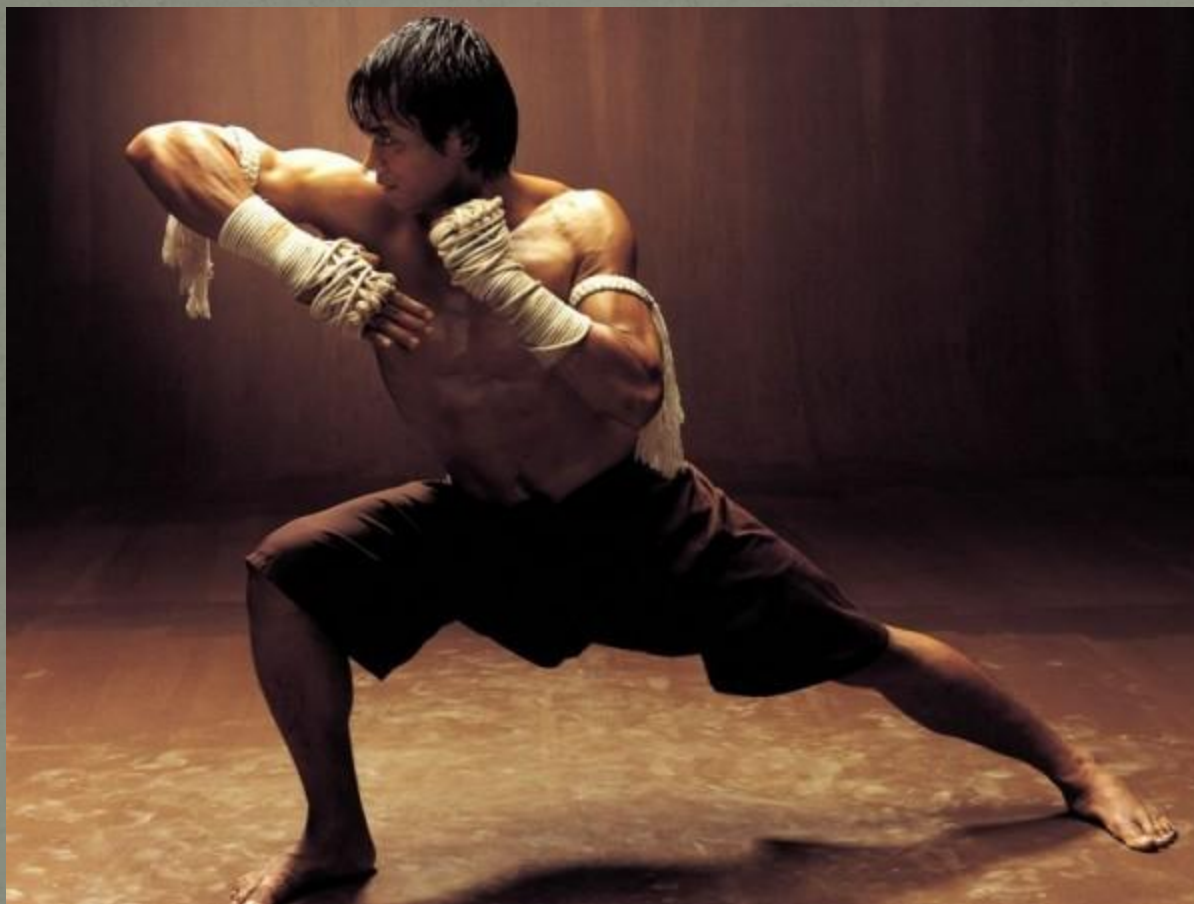

The characters 相撲 literally mean "striking one another".
