***London stands on the river Thames.***

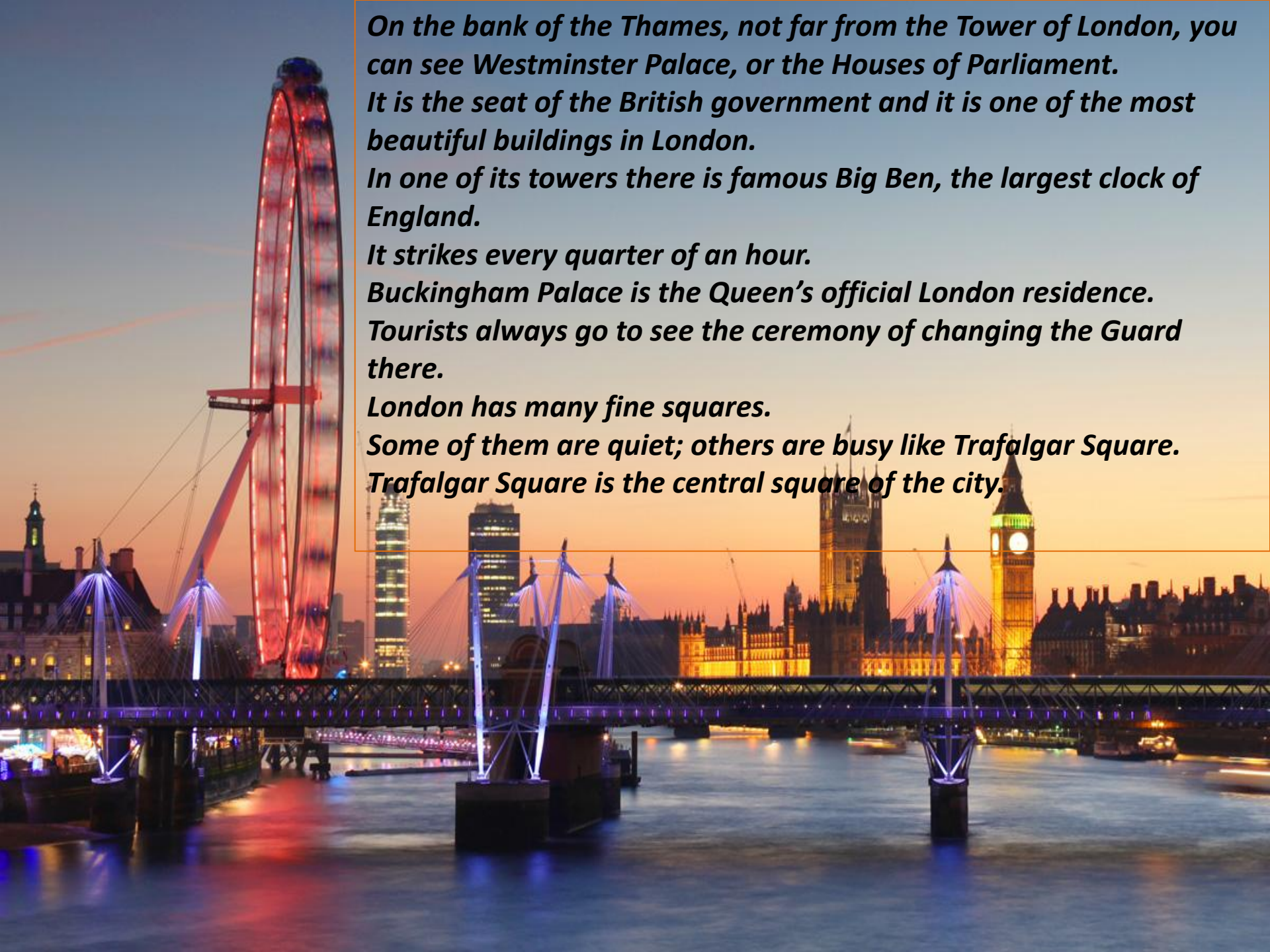
***Crossing the river by the Tower Bridge you can see the Tower of London.***

***Many centuries ago it was a fortress, a royal palace and then a prison.***

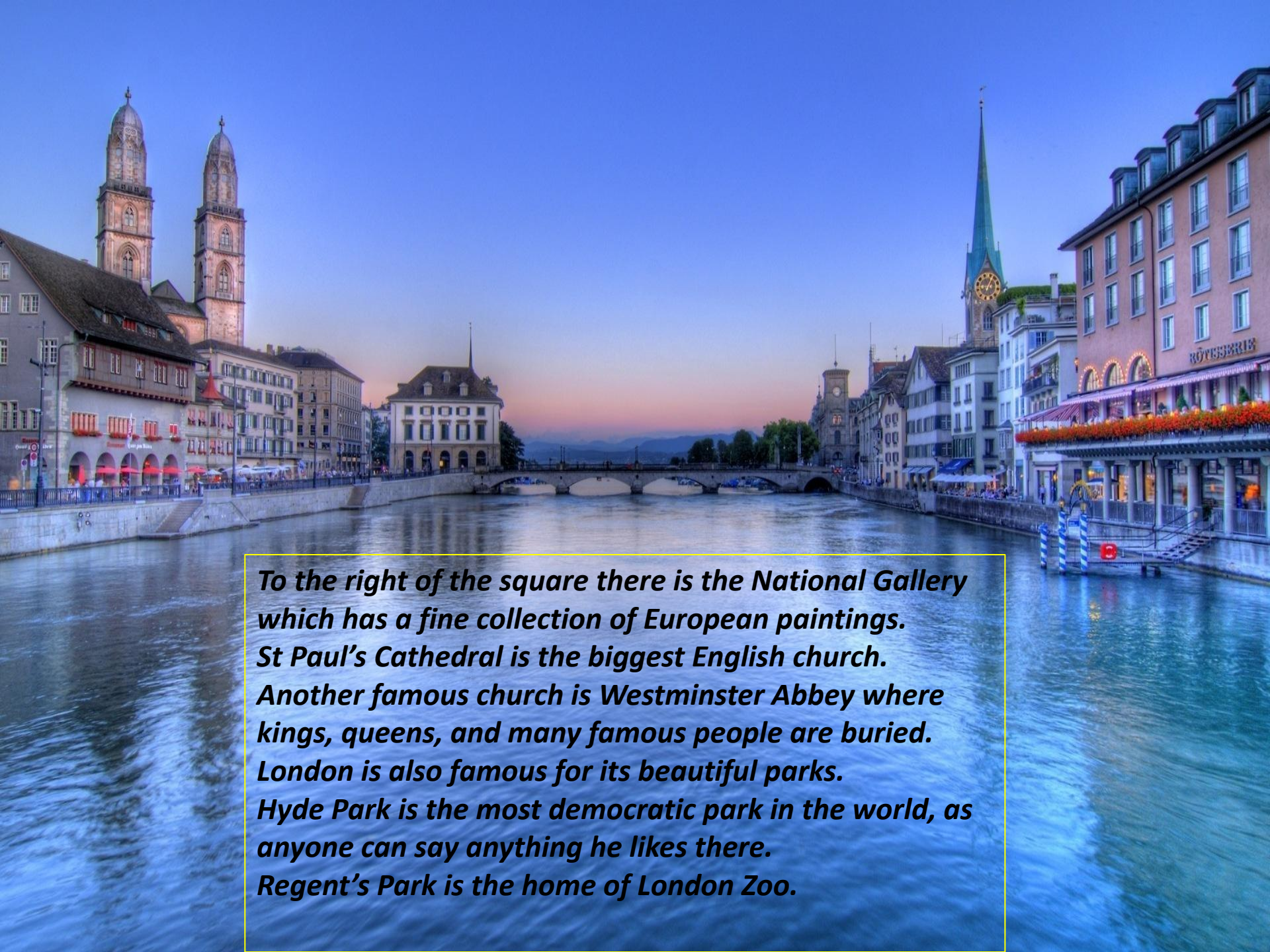
***Now it is a museum of arms.***

Some of them are quiet; others are busy like Trafalgar Square. Trafalgar Square is the central square of the city.***
