The University of Sydney

- The University of Sydney is the oldest and most prestigious university in Australia, controlled by the Ministry of Education, due to the innovative and technically applied nature of education. The specifics of the university's training programs are the development of critical thinking among students, public speaking skills and stimulation of personality-oriented development. Due to the fact that the education system in Australia is built by analogy with the British one, a graduate diploma from the University of Sydney is highly valued.

- Harvard University is one of the most famous universities in the USA and around the world, the oldest university in the USA. It is located in the city of Cambridge (part of the Boston Metropolitan Area), Massachusetts.

- Oxford University is a university in Oxford, England. There is evidence of teaching as early as 1096[2], which makes it the oldest university in the English-speaking world and the second oldest university in the world in continuous operation.[2][10][11] It has grown rapidly since 1167, when Henry II banned English students from attending the University of Paris.[2] After disputes between students and Oxford townspeople in 1209, some scholars fled northeast to Cambridge, where they founded what became the University of Cambridge.[12] Two ancient English universities have many common features and are jointly called Oxbridge. Oxford is one of the most prestigious universities in the world



Cambridge University

- Cambridge University is a university in Great Britain, one of the oldest (second after Oxford) and largest in the country, the fourth oldest in the world[2]. The official status of the university is a privileged charitable institution (exempt charity)[3]. Funding consists of a state educational grant (Higher Education Funding Council), student/postgraduate monetary contributions, donations from charitable foundations, income from Cambridge University Press, grants from the Russell Group and some other sources. In the fiscal year ended July 31, 2019, the total revenue of the central university, excluding colleges, amounted to 2,192 billion pounds, of which 592.4 million pounds were received from research grants and contracts. At the end of the same fiscal year, the central university and colleges together had a combined capital of more than 7.1
