


RELEVANCE OF THE TOPIC

This study was conducted to determine whether additional education is needed. And to find out whether the presence of additional education affects employment.




They were asked eight questions:

- 8. Does having additional vocational education affect employment?


Do you think additional education is currently experiencing a boom or bust?
