The clash of interests on the basis of the availability of additional education in some labour market participants

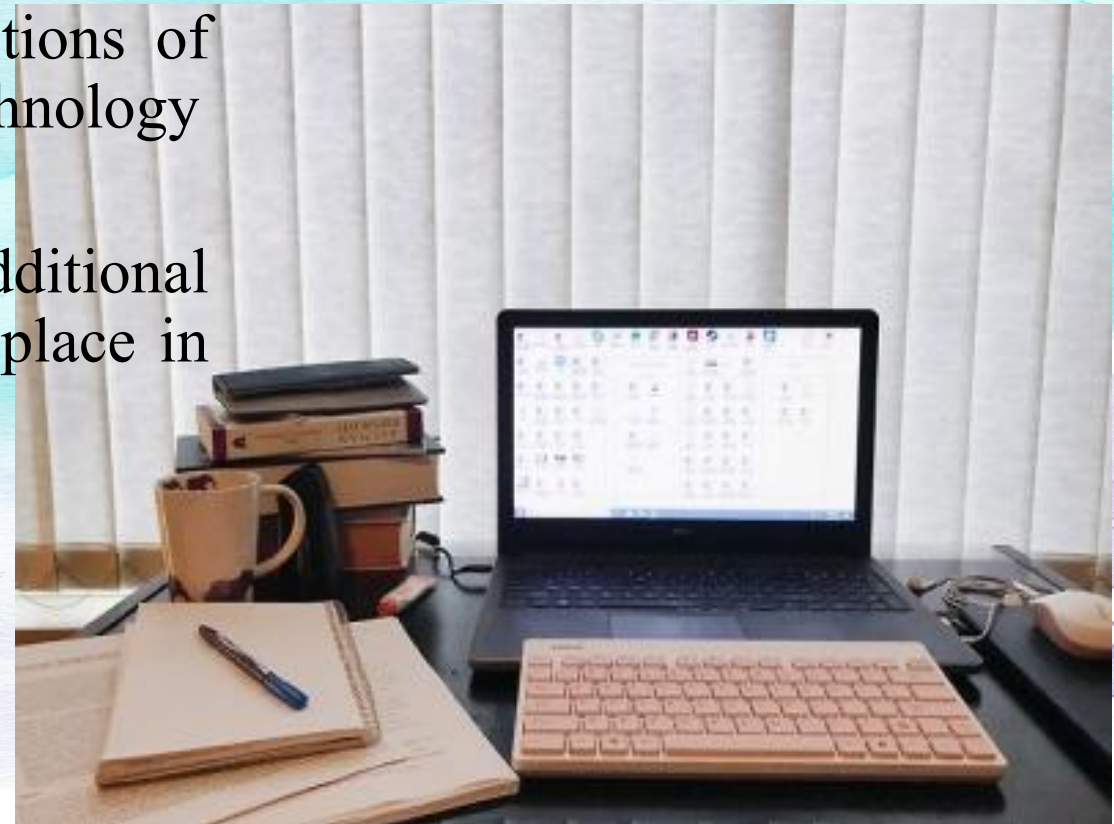

Additional education is one of the ways of competitiveness in the labor market

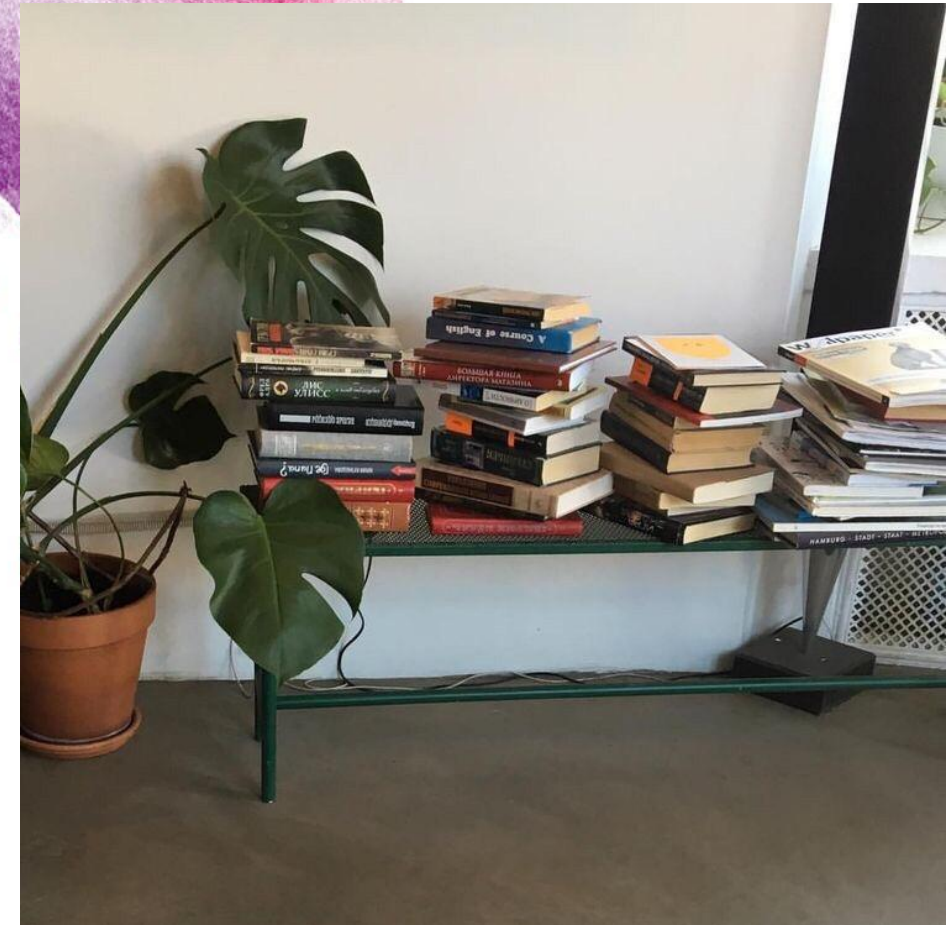
OBJECTIVE OF THE PROJECT

THEORETICAL PART

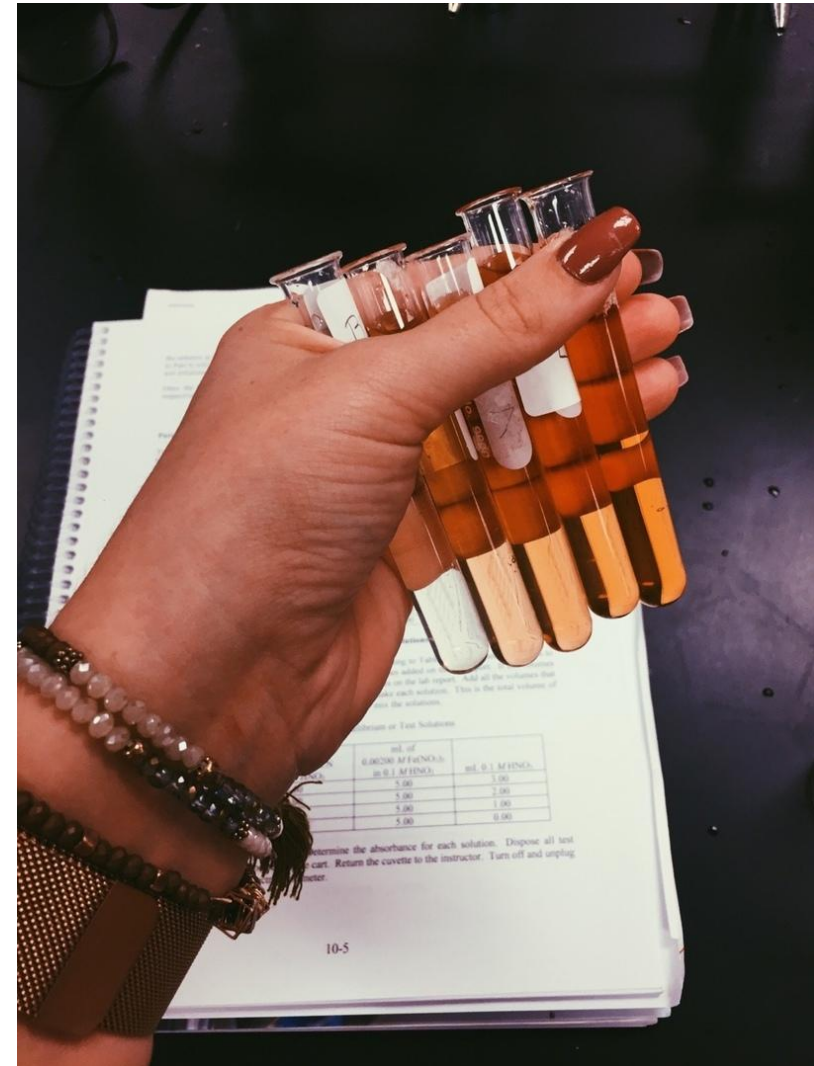
- Supplementary education is an educational program offered to people of any age as an excess, not included in the state educational standard (federal or regional).

This study was conducted to determine whether additional education is needed. And to find out whether the presence of additional education affects employment.

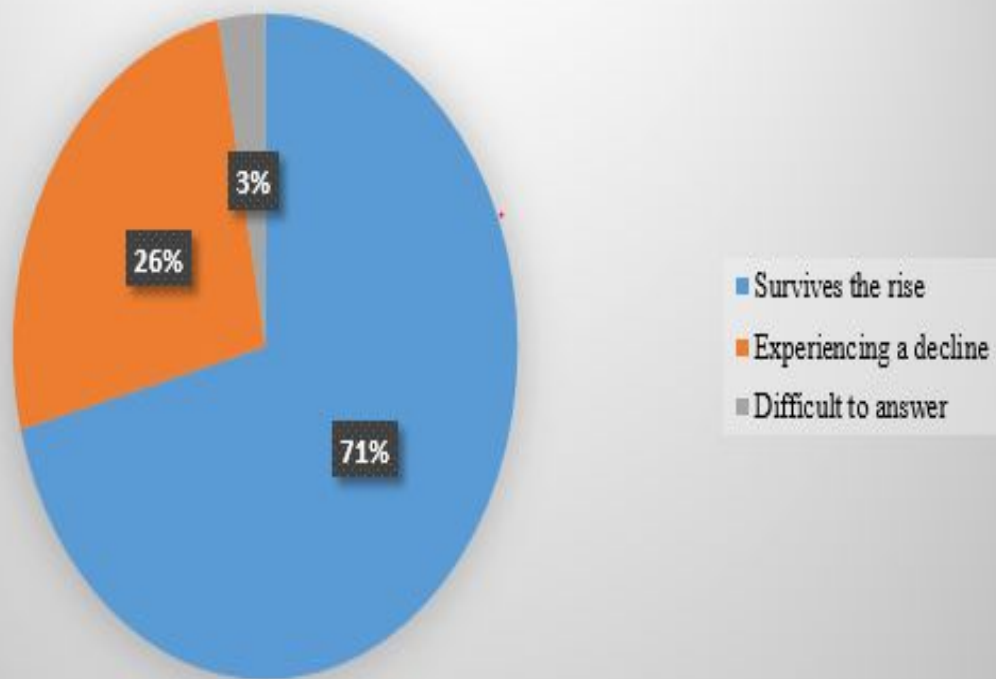

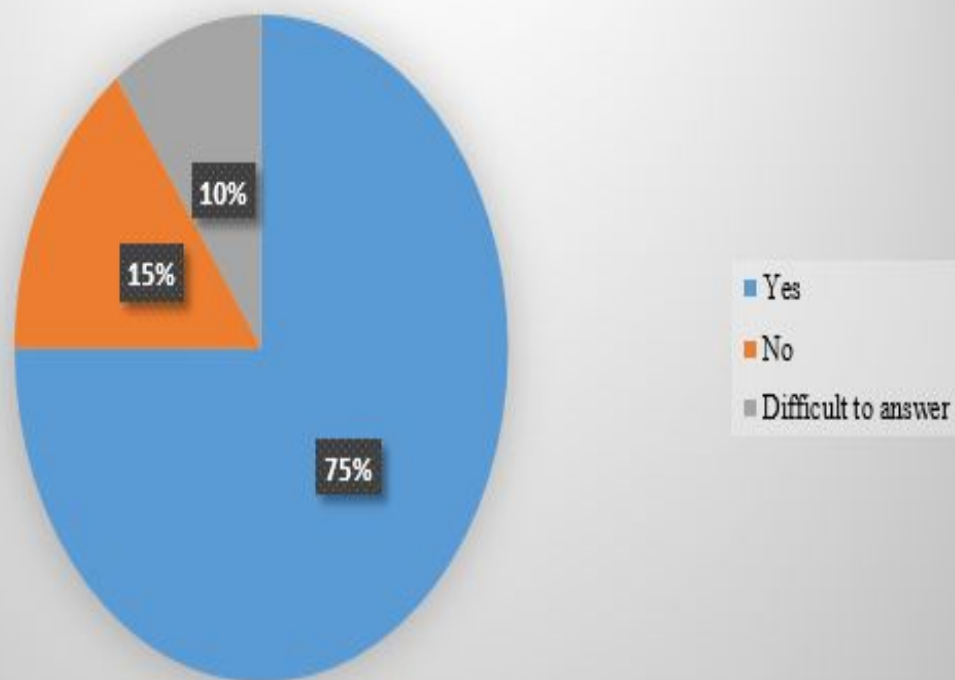
They were asked eight questions:

- 8. Does having additional vocational education affect employment?

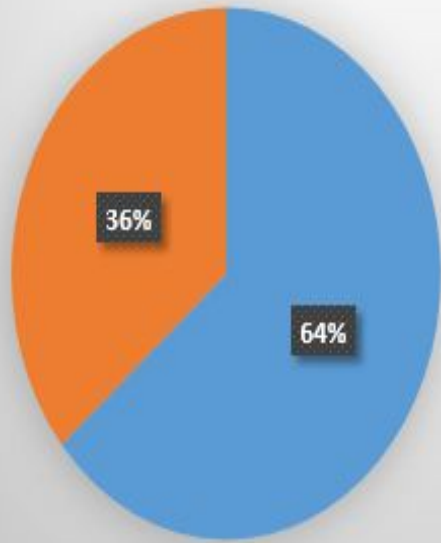
Do you think additional education is currently experiencing a boom or bust?



Do you think it is necessary to get additional education?

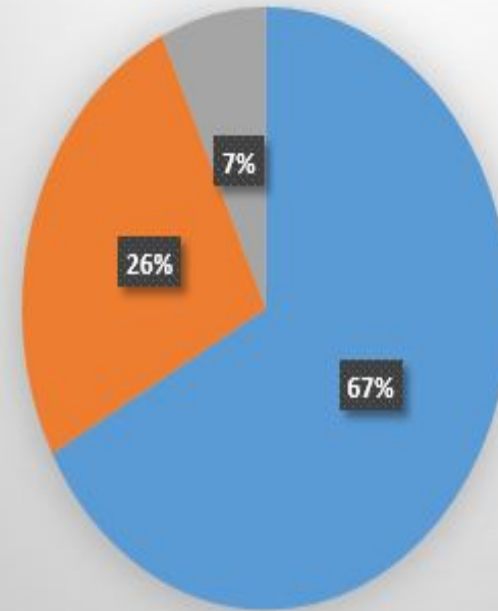


Is it possible to become a true professional in a particular area without additional vocational education?




- No, today you can become a true professional only with constant improvement of skills and abilities.


