

10 PLACES IN MOSCOW TO VISIT

1. MUSEUM OF OPTICAL ILLUSIONS

- To sail on the Titanic, to be among the giant toys, to escape from the evil alligators, to receive an award from the head of state is only a small part of the adventures that await guests in the Museum of Optical Illusions.



- A ticket to the museum costs 350 rubles, is located at: Maly Nikolopeskovsky lane, 4.
- Opening hours: daily from 11:30 to 23:30.

2. ROOF OF THE MULTIMEDIA ART MUSEUM



- If you are going to go to one of the epicenters of the vast exhibition spaces - Multimedia Art Museum - note that there is an amazing place where you can relax, discuss modern photography or just enjoy tea or coffee. It's all about the roof of Multimedia Art Museum.
- What is there: cleanliness, comfort, open space, view of the center of Moscow, free tea, coffee and even hammocks, where guests can lie down and relax.

- Opening hours: 12:00 - 21:00, except Monday.
- Entrance to the roof from 18 years.

3. THEATER "PRACTICE"

- Five minutes walk from Mayakovskaya metro station, in the courtyard-well of the apartment building there is an experimental theater of the new drama "Praktika". You can even see the colored arch with a running line, where information about upcoming events is displayed, can be done from Bolshoi Kozikhinsky Lane.

- "Practice" is a state theater for 87 seats, where not only do performances with famous actors, but also hold film screenings, exhibitions, trainings, performances and poetic evenings.

4. CULTURAL CENTER ZIL



- This is the first and largest Palace of Culture in Moscow. Here you can visit an interesting lecture, exhibition, master class, film club and more.

5. DESIGN-FACTORY "FLACON"



- The place was created in 2009 on the territory of the former glass factory of Frederick Dutfoy of the late 19th century. Now it is one of the most popular art clusters of the capital, where you can watch an exhibition, listen to a lecture, and see a film at a film club, as well as work and eat.
- Address: Bolshaya Novodmitrovskaya St., 36 Building 2.

6. CAFE AND RECORDING STUDIO DEWAR'S POWERHOUSE



- This is a club, a recording studio, a restaurant and coworking combined under one roof. And if in a cafe music usually serves as a background, here everything serves as a background for music.
- The room is divided into several floors: in the basement there is a recording studio, a sound producer, where one of the most famous Internet radio Follow Me is now located. On the second floor there is a restaurant, bar and dance floor. There are no expensive dishes or something fanciful, you can safely drink coffee and a snack. The menu also has cocktails, a list of which is presented on more than ten pages.

7. RUSSIAN STATE LIBRARY FOR YOUNG PEOPLE



- The updated library for young people is now one of the favorite places for Moscow students (and not only), where in a modern setting you can not only read good books, but also visit various clubs: ecological, for fans of comics, philosophical and not only.

8.COMPUTER EVOLUTION GALLERY



- If painting and photography are no longer inspiring and you want to look at something unusual, but also quite real, visit the Gallery of computer evolution will be just the way. Here you can plunge into the past of modern technologies and go to the ancestors of the ancestors of the usual iPad and smartphones.
- Among the exhibits of the gallery you can find such rarities as the 1980 Tesla EAM-500 tape recorder, old processors, an electronic notebook of 1989, punched cards, a Motorola pager and more.
- In addition to exploring the exposition, you can get a little distracted and remember your childhood by playing the famous game console Dendy.

9. CENTRAL HOUSE OF ARTISTS



- Since 1956 and until now, the Central House of Artists is a unique complex where you can visit exhibitions, concerts, lectures and watch movies in a film club.

10. MUSEUM OF ANIMATION IN MOSCOW



- Now in the museum you can see more than 5,000 exhibits, some of which are interactive, learn the history of creating a favorite cartoon, and also feel yourself like an artist at a master class. On top of that, here every hour there are guided tours and even there are off-site holidays with cartoon attractions.
