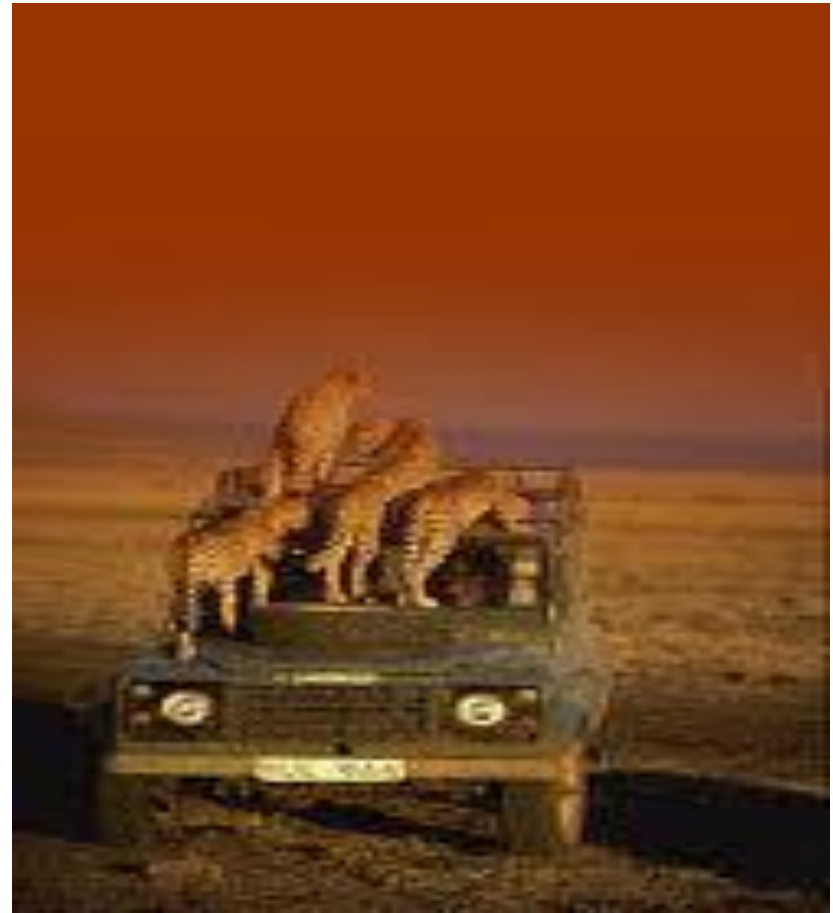

Kenya has different kinds of food. The most popular food is Ugali and Githeri. The first picture is Ugali. The second picture is Githeri.



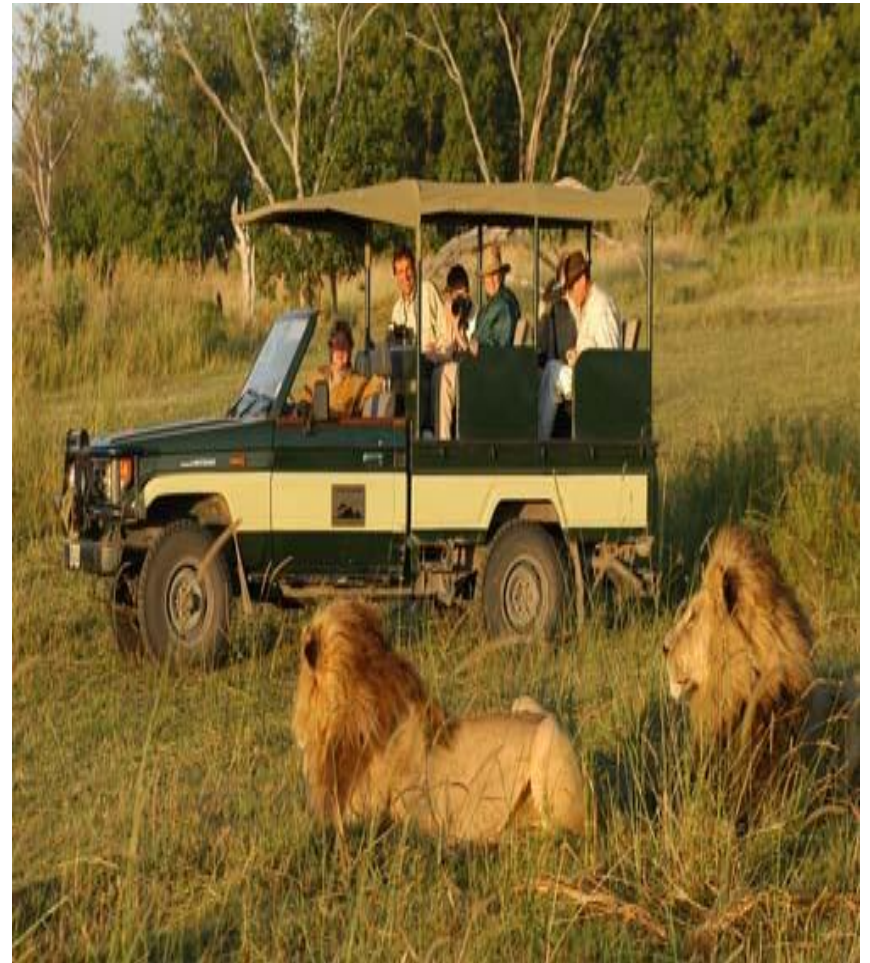
Chapati is a popular dish in Kenya. People usually cook chapati during celebrations, happy birthdays, weddings and other big occasions.
