## Resources Donetsk region

- Minerals
- Nedra area rich in various minerals, of which the most important is coal (Donets Basin). Substantial deposits of rock salt (Bahmutskiy Slavic and deposits). Mineral resources base of industry of building materials and ferrous metallurgy is represented by significant deposits of dolomite, limestone (flux and construction -Dokuchaevsk, Komsomolsk, village Novotroitskoye), refractory (Chasov, Novorayskoe, Andreev, Zatyshanskoe, Veselovskoye, Oktyabrsky deposits) and plastic (ceramic - Kramatorsk, Kurdyumovskoe, Kuteynikovskoe, Nikolaev, Rye Alexandrov, Nikiforovsky deposit) clay, marl (Amvrosiivka Raion, the city Kramatorsk district), gypsum (Bahmutskiy district), kaolin (Vladimir, Bogoroditskoe, Ekaterinovskiy field), chalk (Slavic area), construction and quartz sand, granite (Telmanovskiy, Volodarsky district), quartzite and more...



 There are also mercury (Mykytivske deposit), mineral paints (ocher - Yasnaya Polyana deposit), phosphates (Reznikovskii Osykovskoe and field), asbestos, graphite (in the Sea of Azov). Were found deposits of nepheline syenite (aluminum ore - Kalinino-Shevchenko deposit), fluorite (fluorspar - Petrovo Gnutovskoe and Cover-Kireevsk field), vermiculite (Kamennomogilnoe field), iron ore (in the Sea of Azov), dawsonite, potassium salt (about Slavonic). In the northern areas of the region is the Dnieper-Donets oil and gas area (in practically developed) in the south, on the coast of the sea - Black sea-Crimean oil and gas province. Exploited mineral springs (Dobropole, Novoazovsk). On the border of Donetsk and Kharkiv regions Hughes is shale gas.

## Climate

• It is located in the steppe zone, the climate is temperate continental, with little snow winters and hot summers. Average January temperatures from -5 to -8 ° C, 21-23 ° C in July. Precipitation about 500 mm per year. In the spring there are dry winds (often - in May), and sometimes - dust storms, hail.
