Types of questions

Существуют 5 типов вопросов в англ. языке:

- 1. Общий, General question
- 2. Специальный, Special question
- 3. Разделительный, Tag question
- 4. Альтернативный, Disjunctive question
- 5. Вопрос к подлежащему, Subject question

General/Special questions (общий/специальный вопросы)

Общий вопрос подразумевает ответ «да» или «нет», обратный порядок слов. Вопрос начинается с вспомогательного глагола.

Do you like coffee?-Yes, I do./ No, I don't.

Have you done your homework?-Yes, I have./No, I haven't. (have not)


<u>Специальный вопрос</u> требует развернутого ответа. Обратный порядок слов, но на первое место ставятся вопросительные местоимения when, where, what....

What do you like?- I like coffee.
What have you done?- I have done my homework.


Чтобы правильно построить вопрос, нужно знать правила образования времен. См. таблицу спряжения глаголов (построение вопросов).



The Present Perfect Tense. General/Special questions



Have/has+_____+Ved/iii? -общий вопрос в The Present Perfect Tense
Wh-+Have/has+_____+Ved/iii?-специальный вопрос в The Present Perfect Tense
They have done their homework. Have they done their homework? What have they done?

Ex.1 Ask 2 questions to each sentence (general/special)

- 1. Kim likes to travel abroad.-Does Kim like to travel? What does Kim like to do?
- 2. She lives in London.
- 3. The train leaves at 6 p.m. 5.
- 4. I usually get to the station by taxi.
- 5. I am playing computer games now.
- 6. She is watching television at the moment.
- 7. I am studying Mathematics now.
- 8. She has just painted a picture
- 9. Sasha has been to England.
- 10. I have just read a dialogue "Welcome to London".
